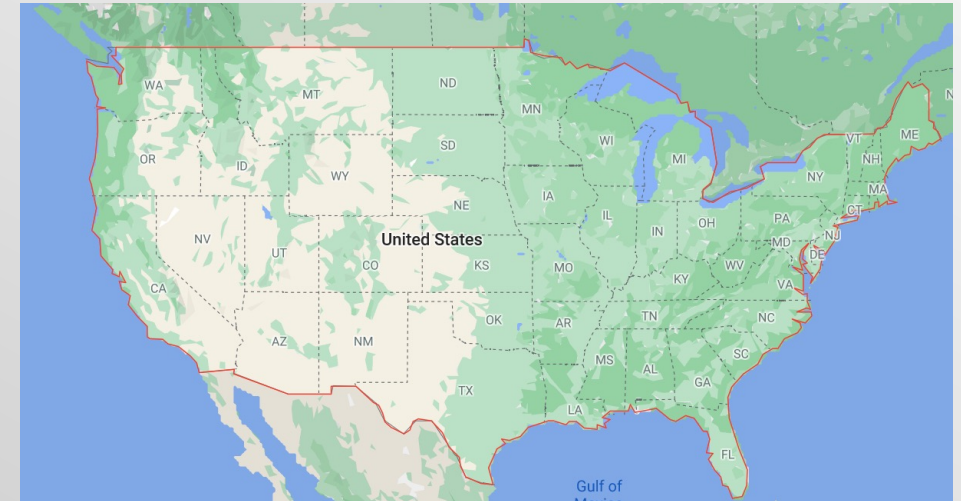

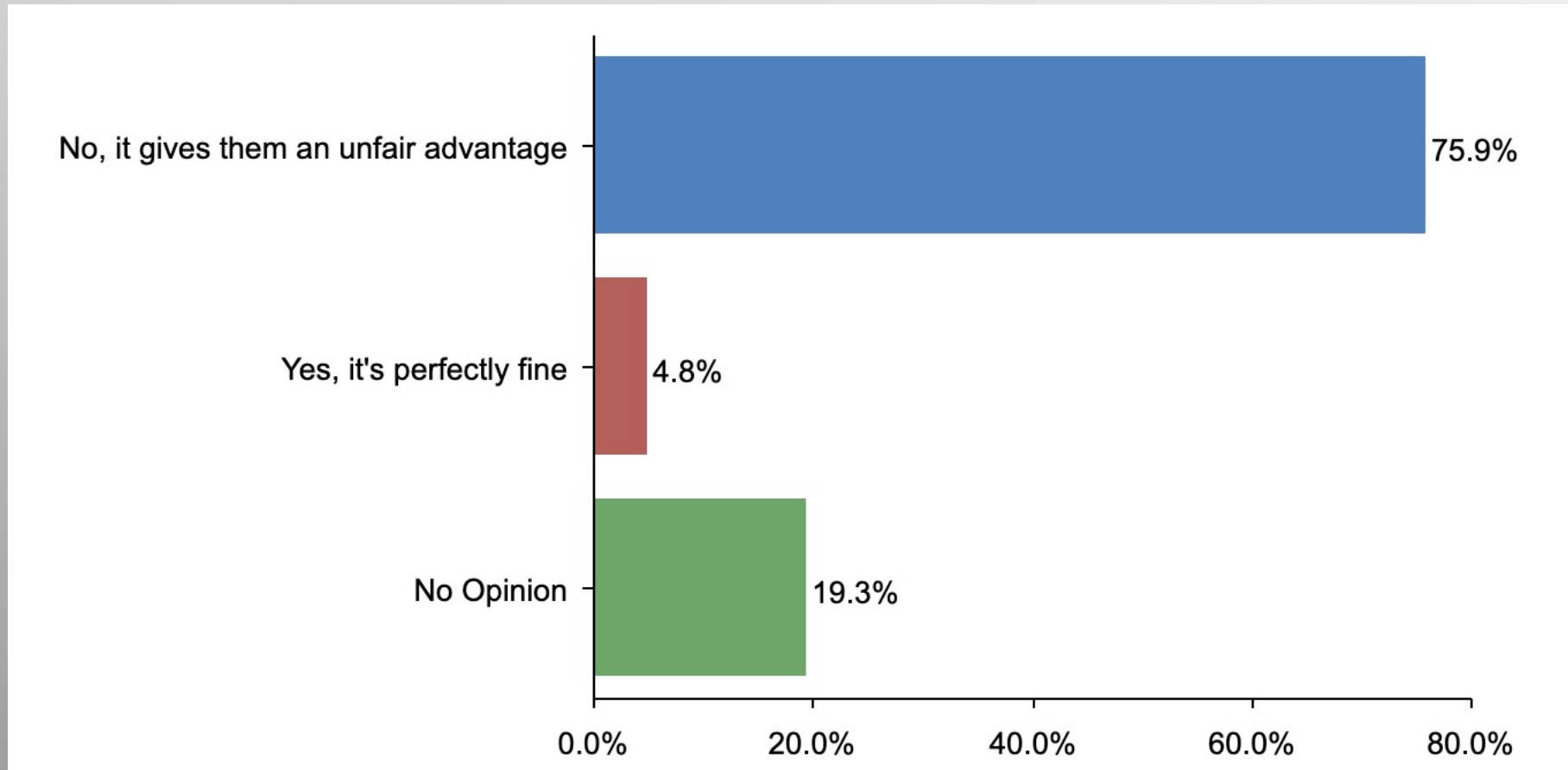

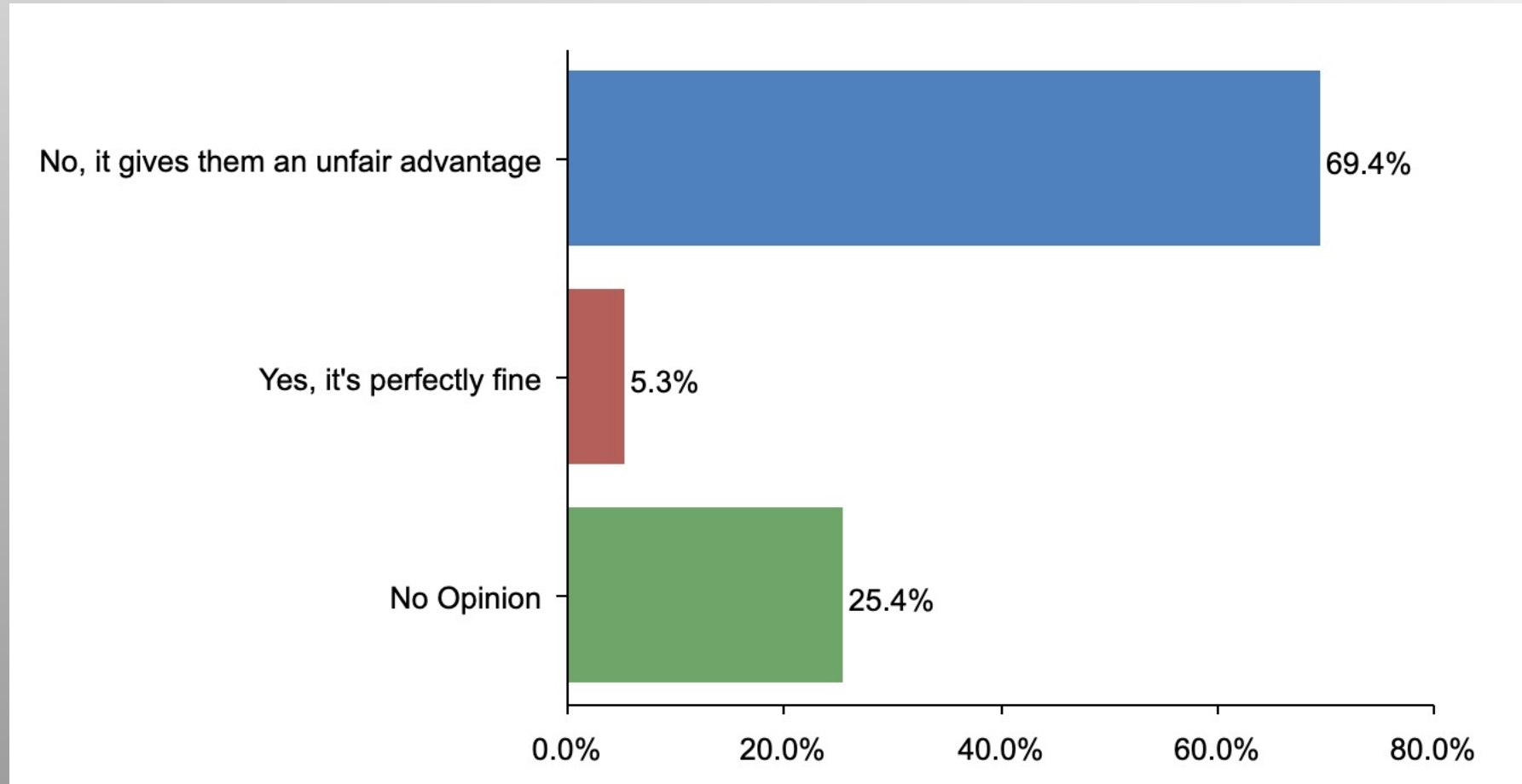

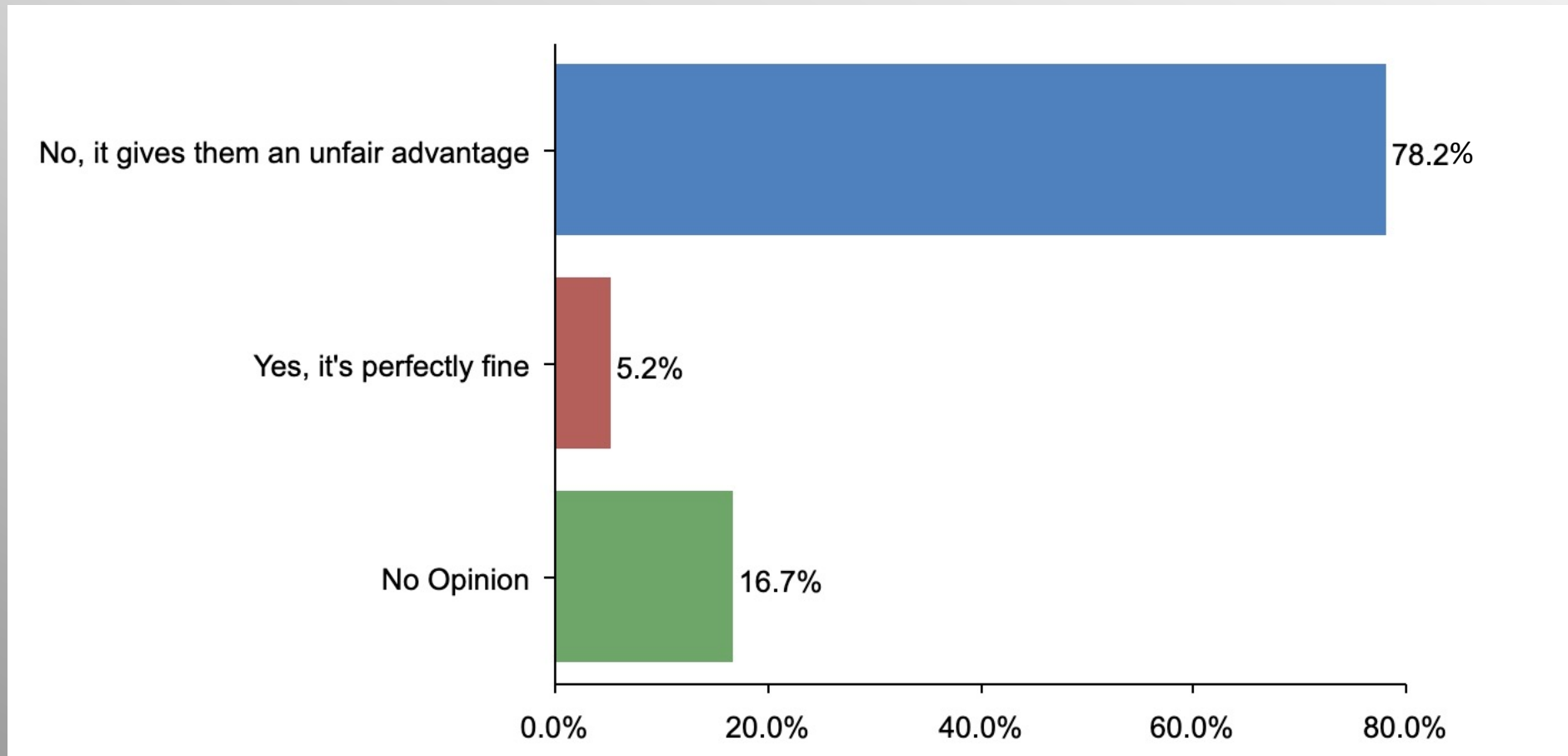
Congress/Stocks (Democrats)

Should members of Congress and their spouses be allowed to trade stocks while serving in Congress?



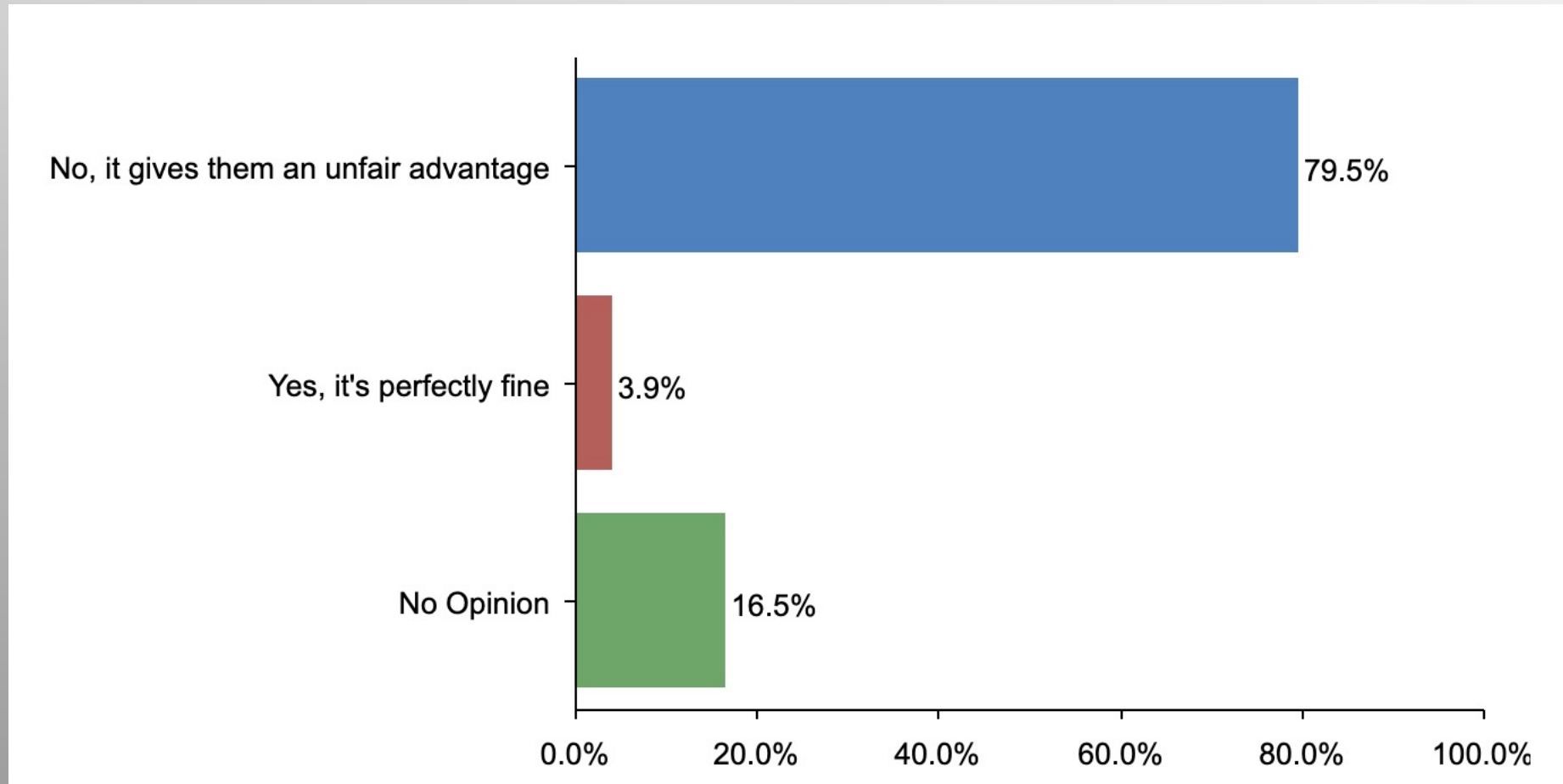
Congress/Stocks (GOP)

Should members of Congress and their spouses be allowed to trade stocks while serving in Congress?

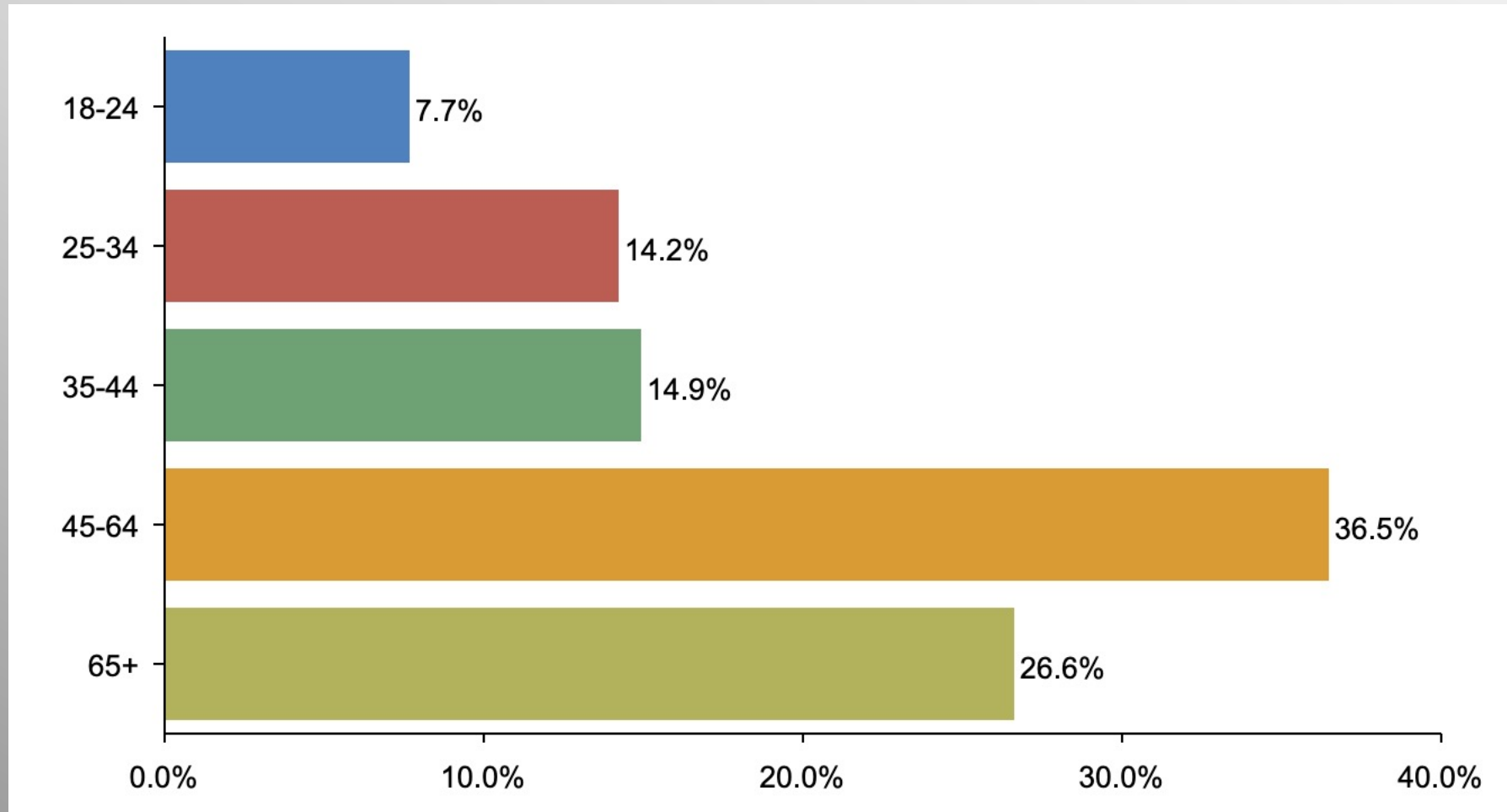

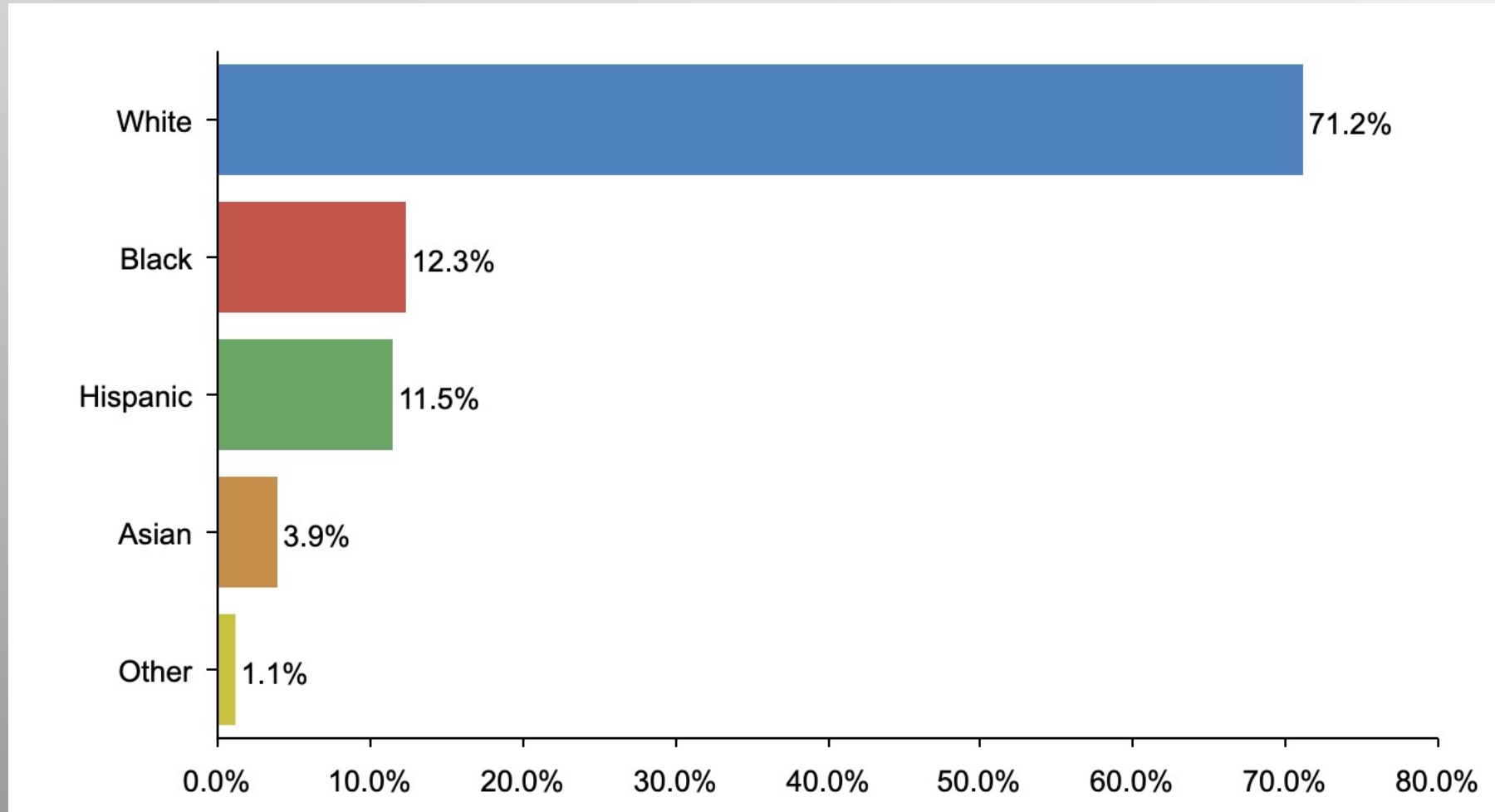

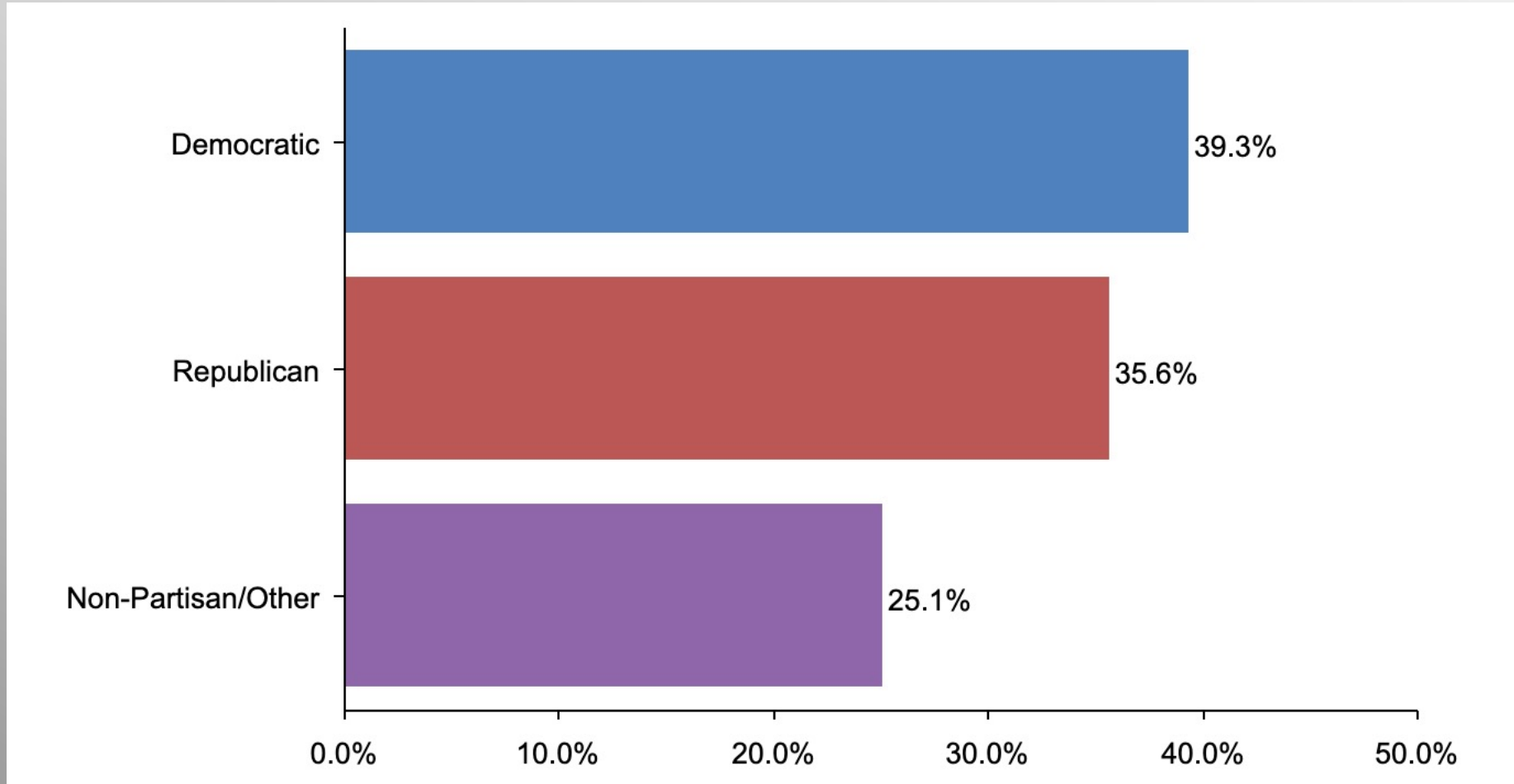
Age Participation



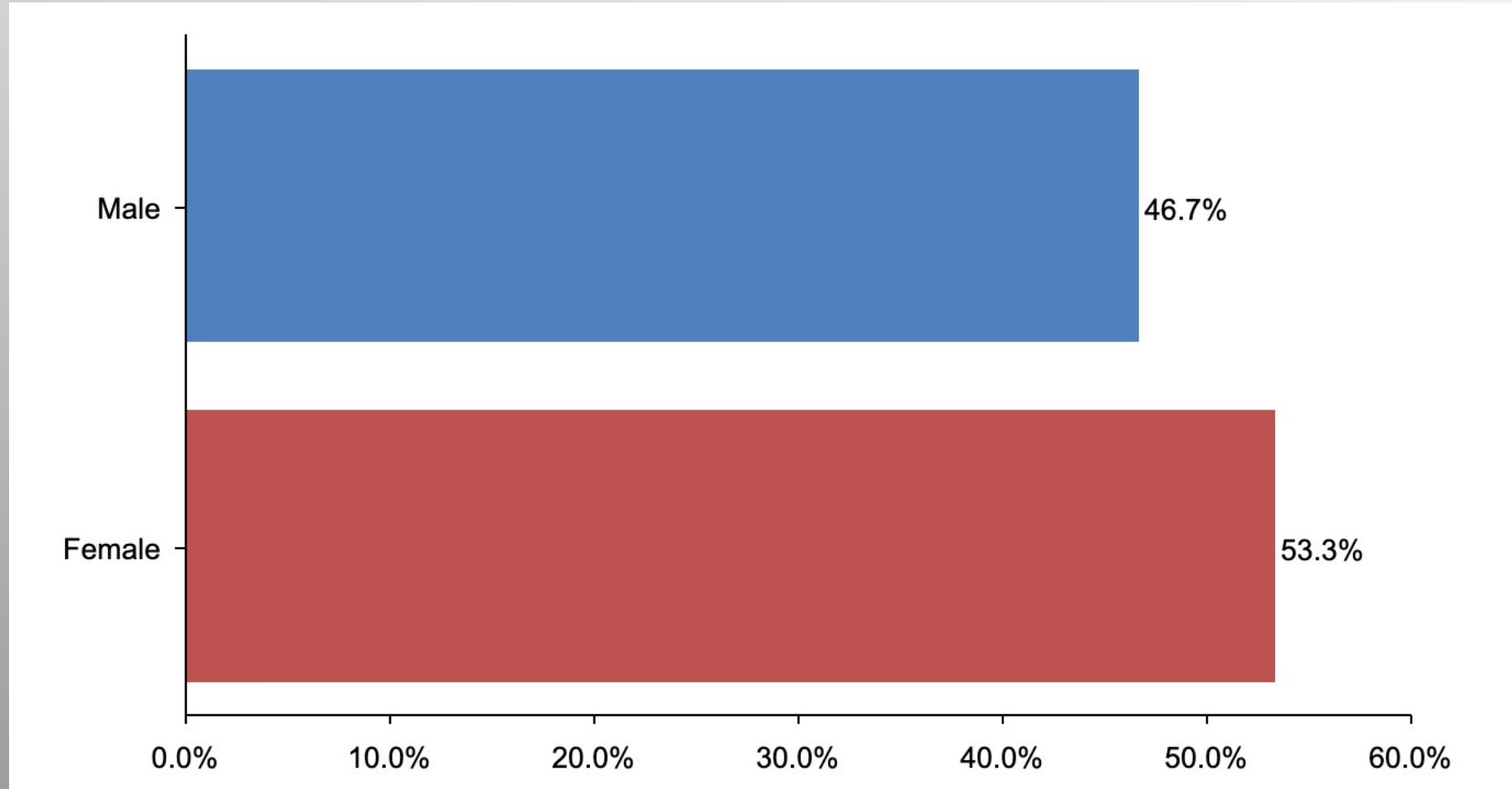
Ethnicity Participation
