


Buckhead Vote Opinion





Buckhead Vote Legislative Support






GOP Primary - Governor




If your choices in the Republican primary election for Governor were the following, for whom would you most likely vote?



GOP Primary – Governor (Trump endorsement)




Has Donald Trump made an endorsement in the Georgia Governor's race?



GOP Primary – US Senate




If the Republican primary election for US Senate were held tomorrow, for whom would you most likely vote?








