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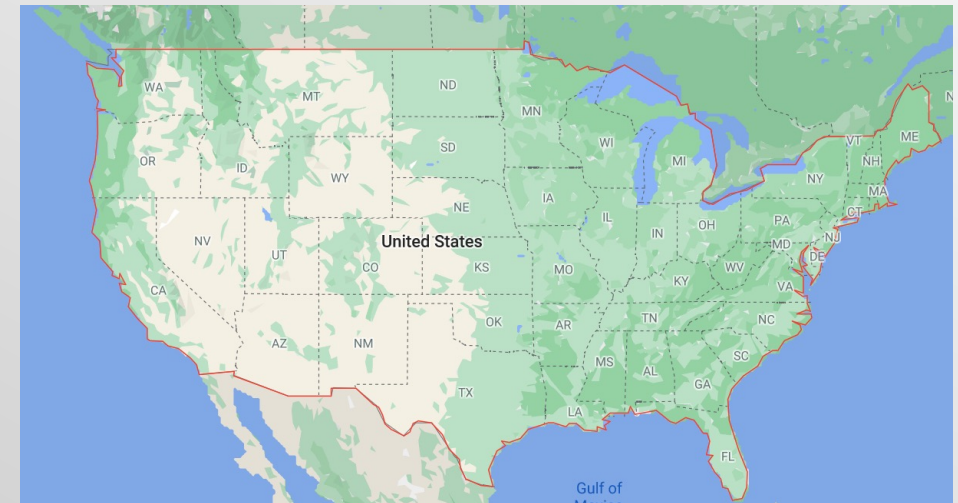

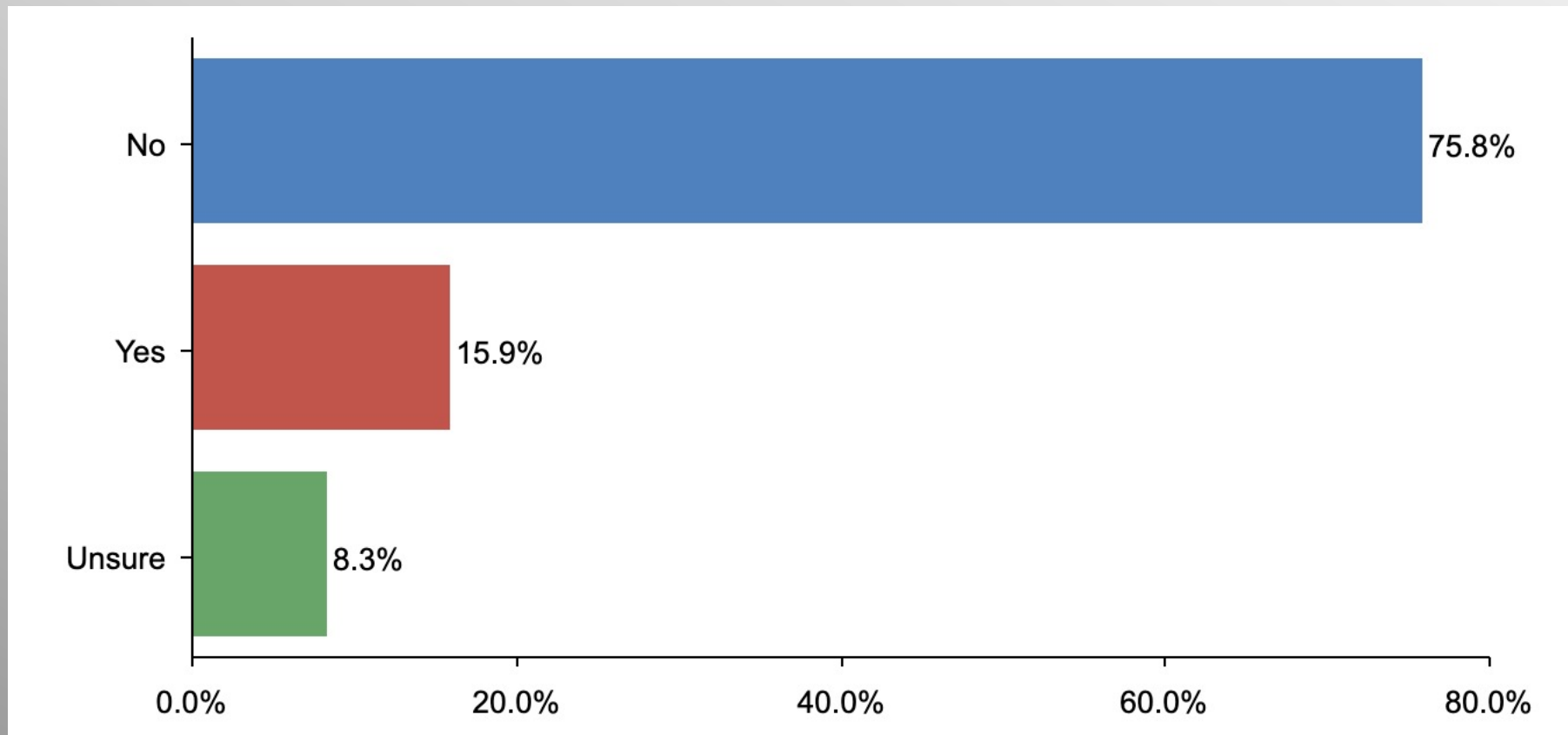


- **Conducted 05/06/22 - 05/08/22**

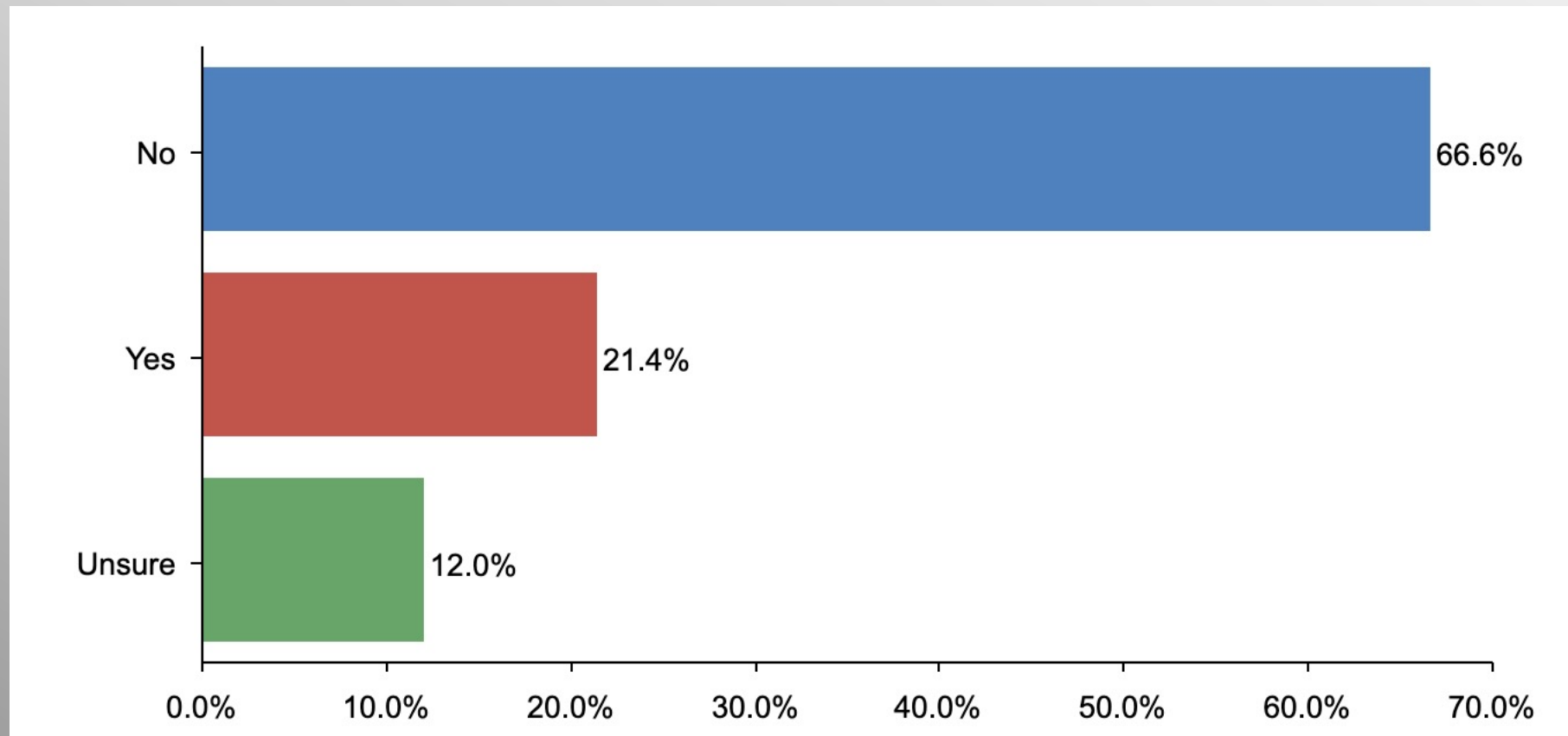

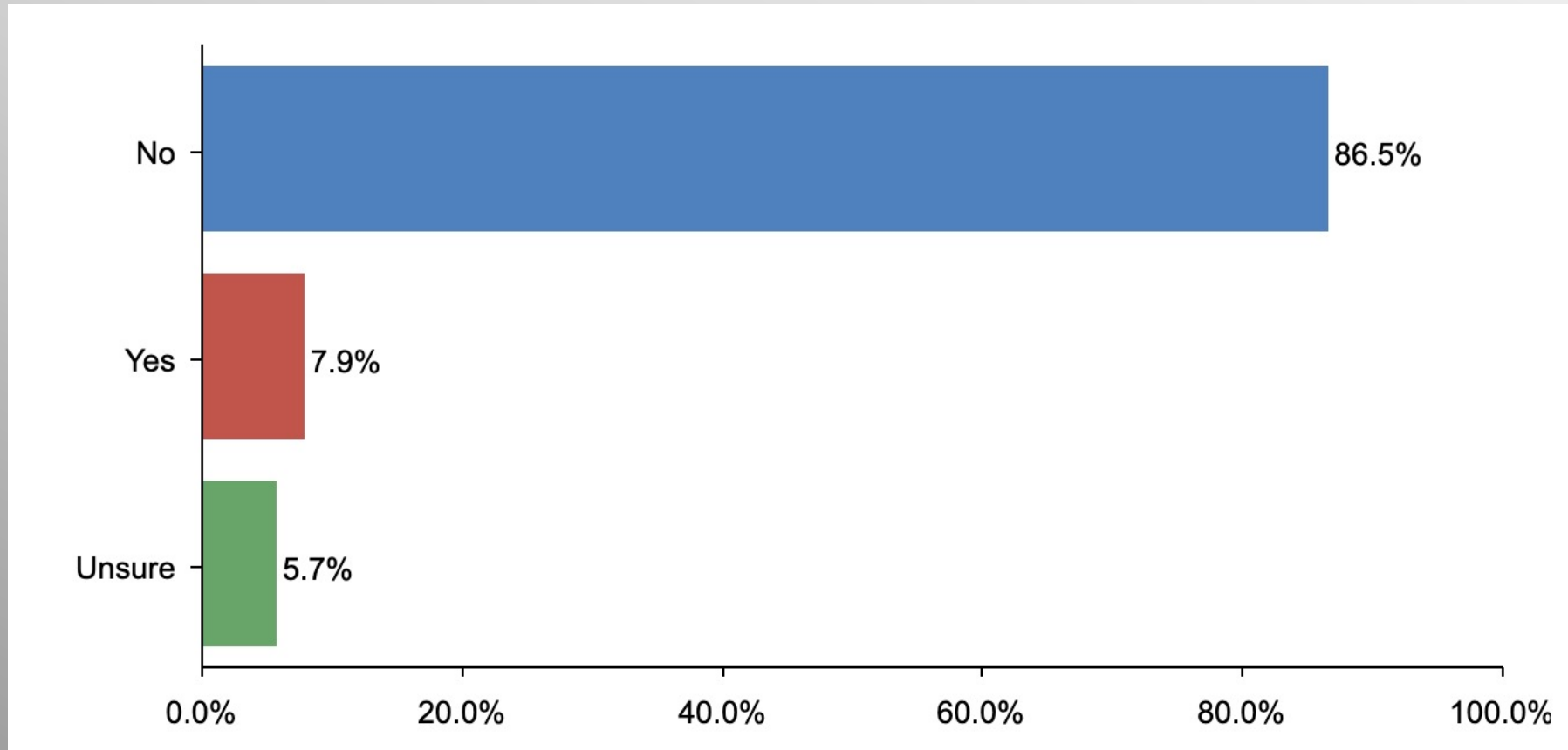

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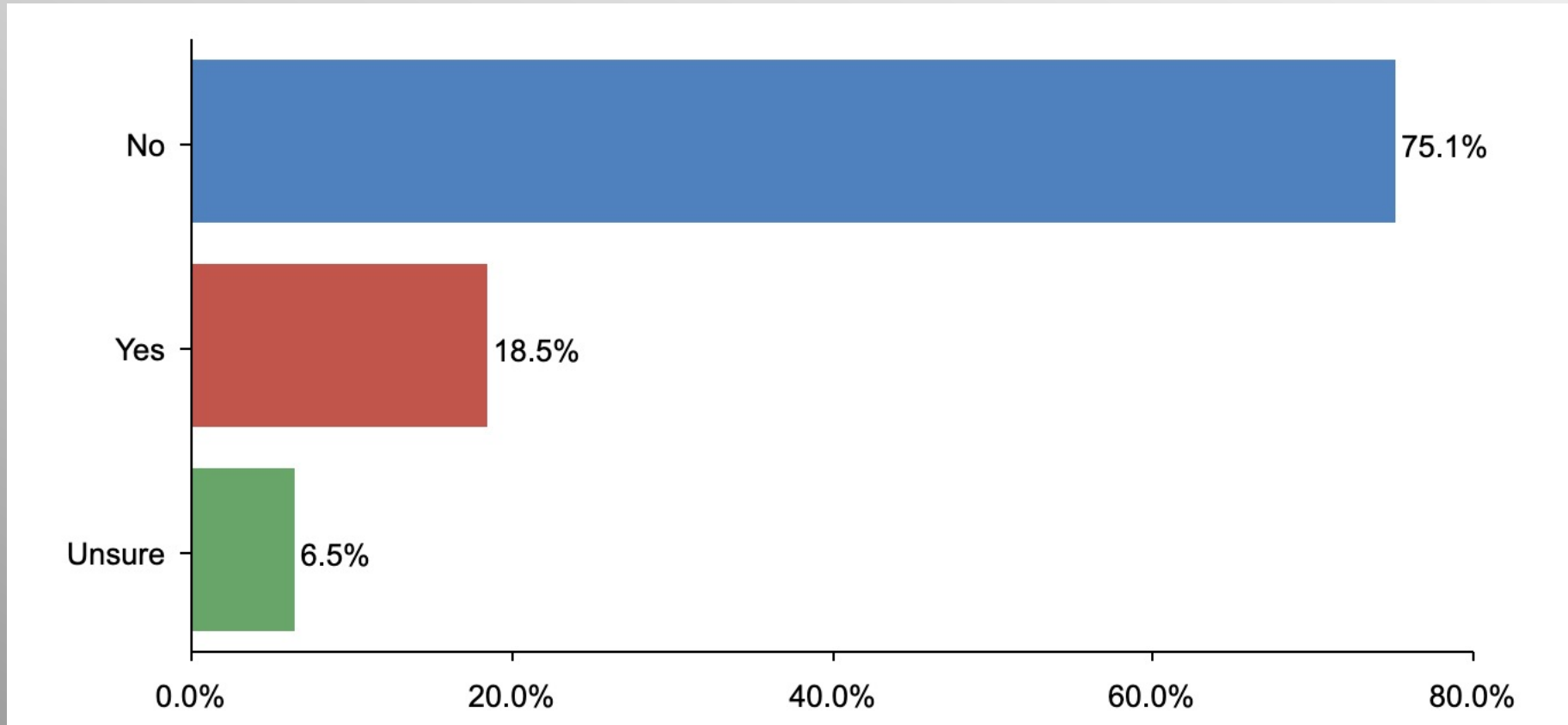

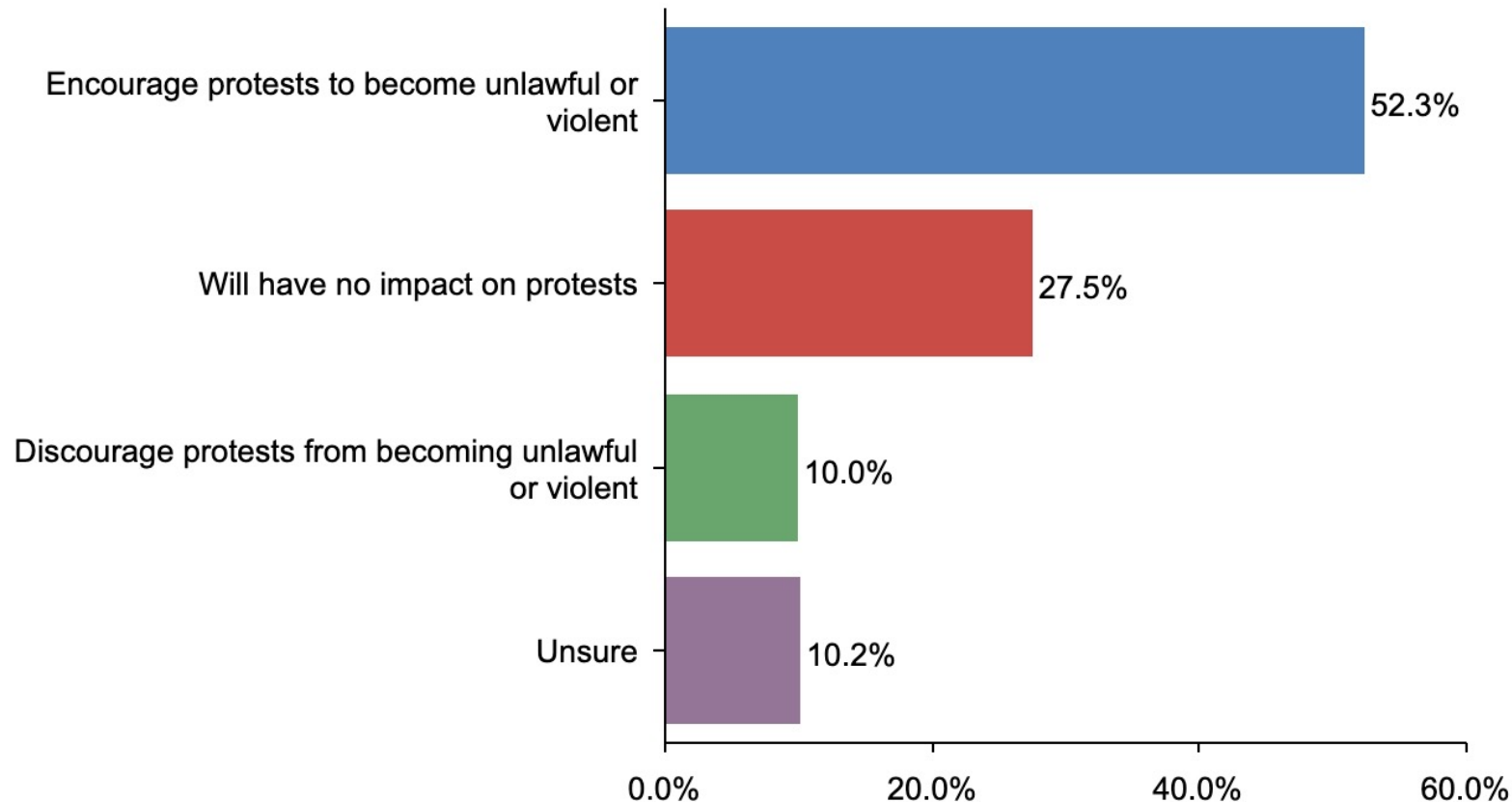

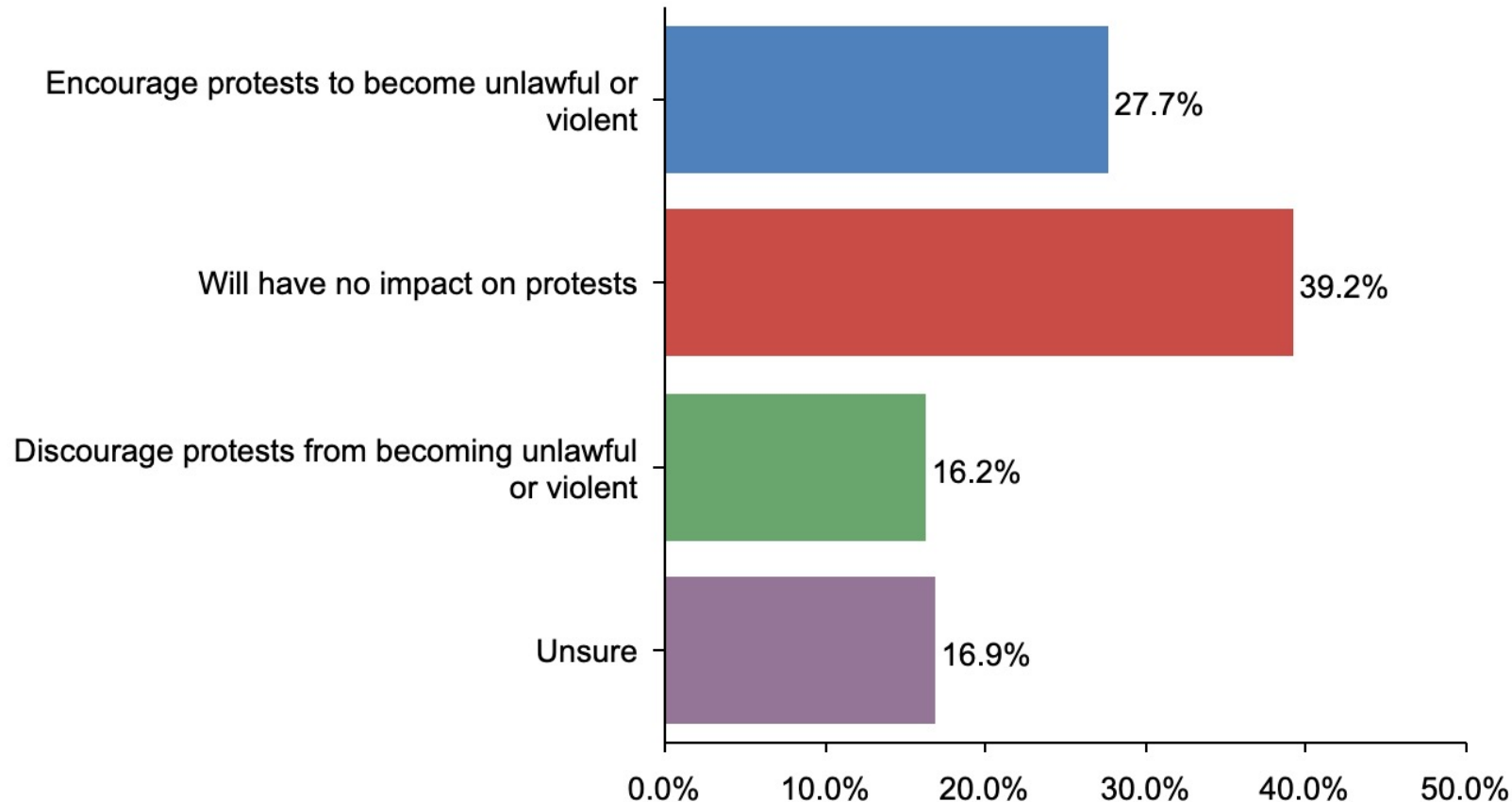

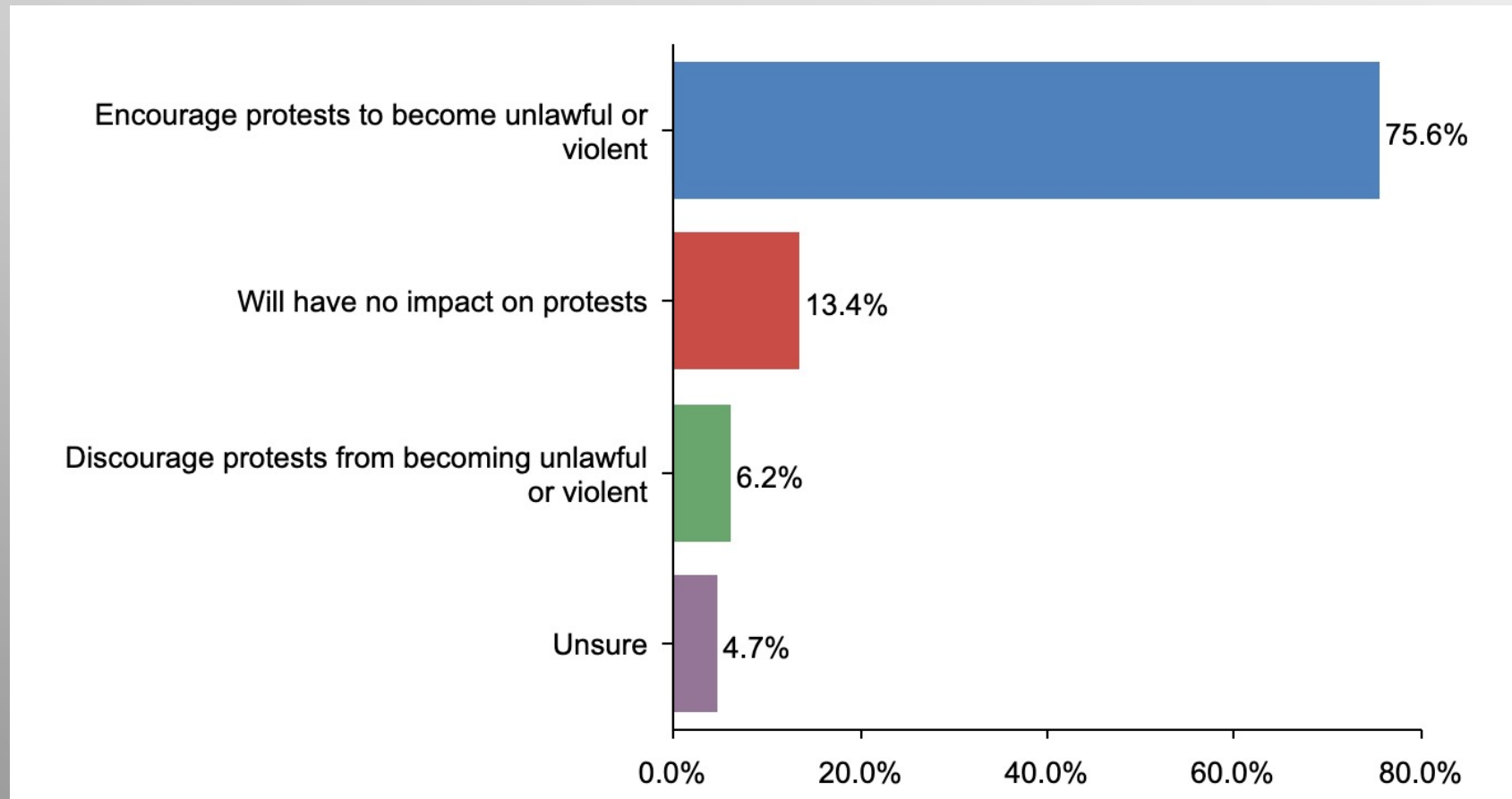

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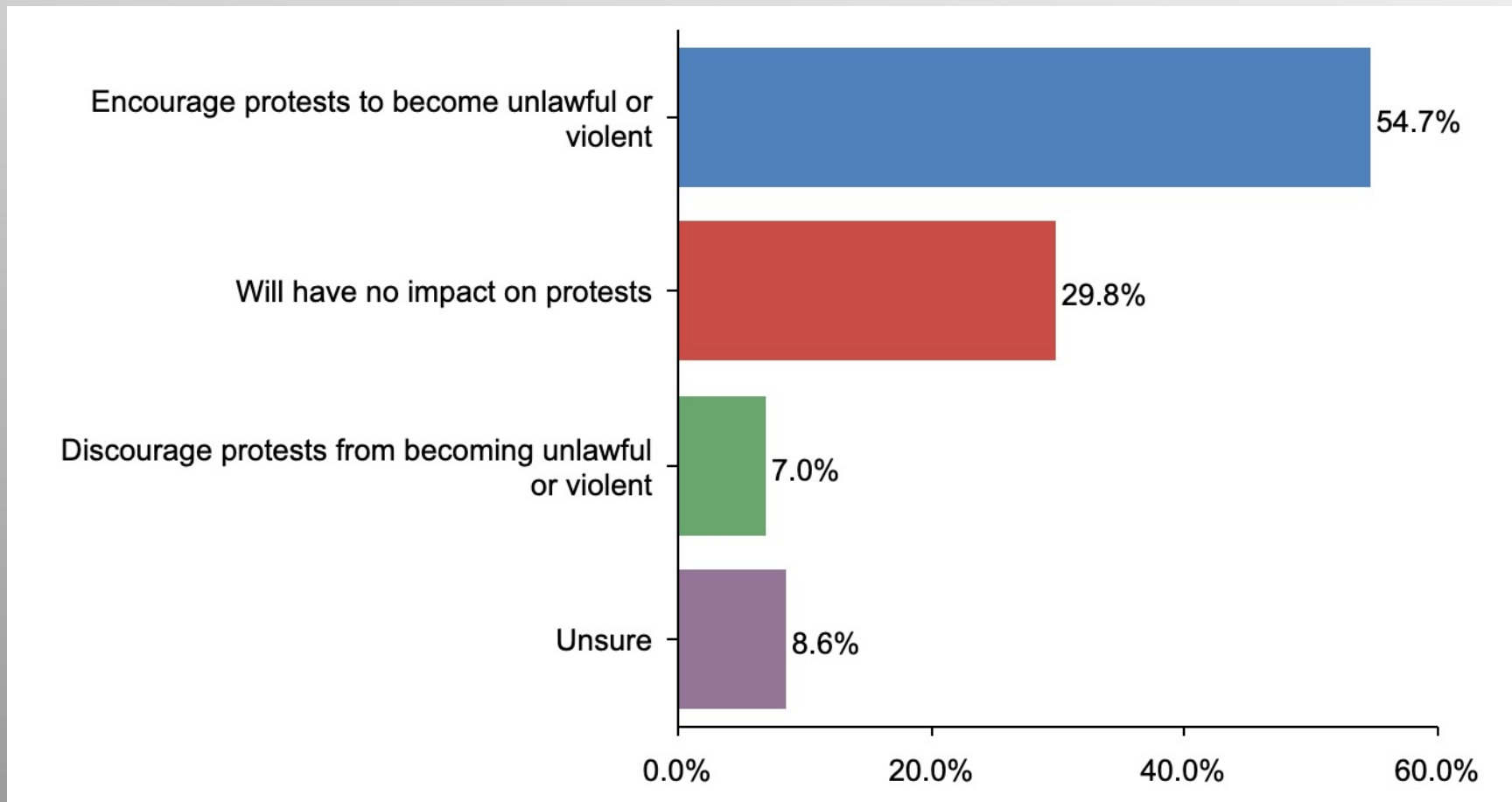

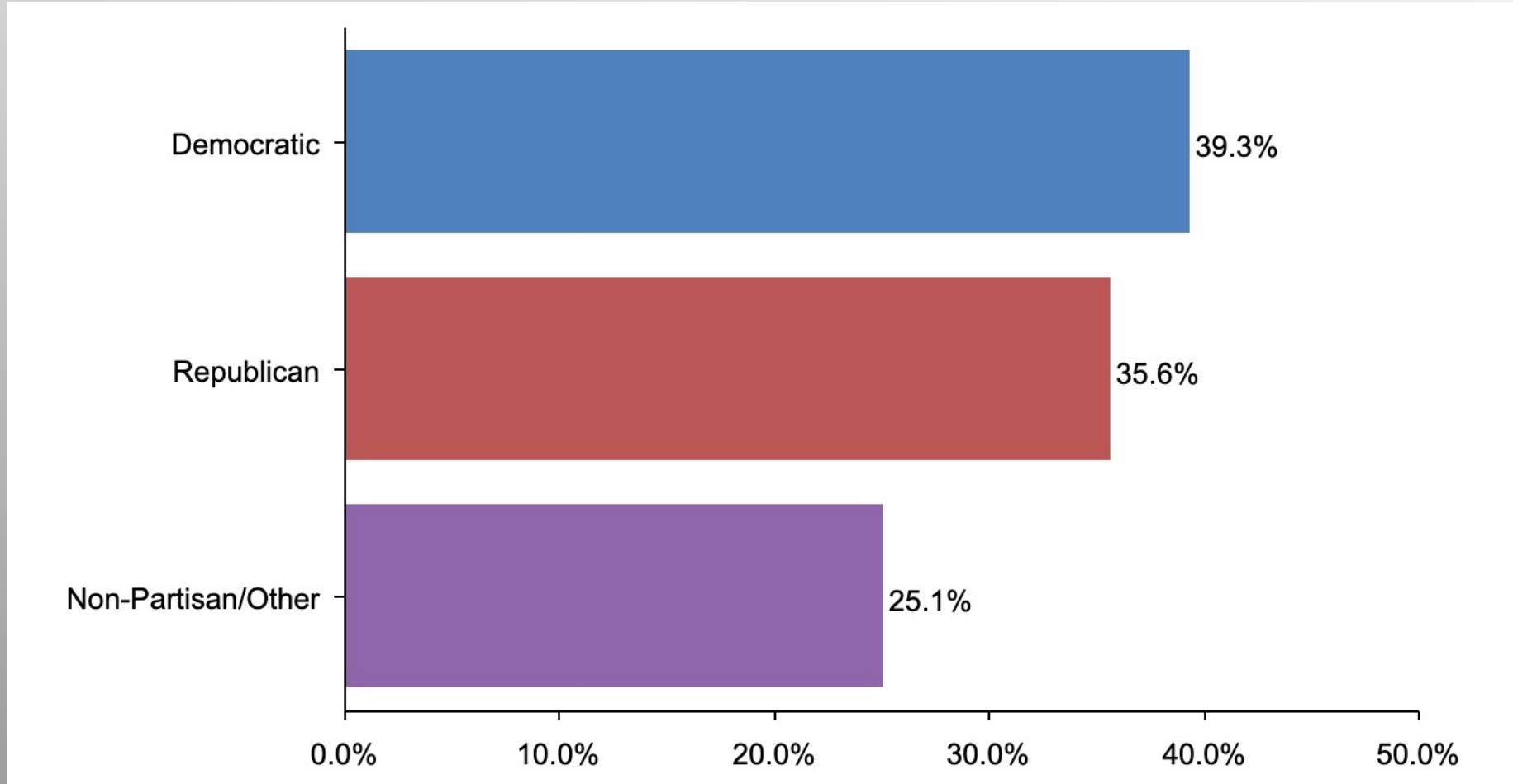

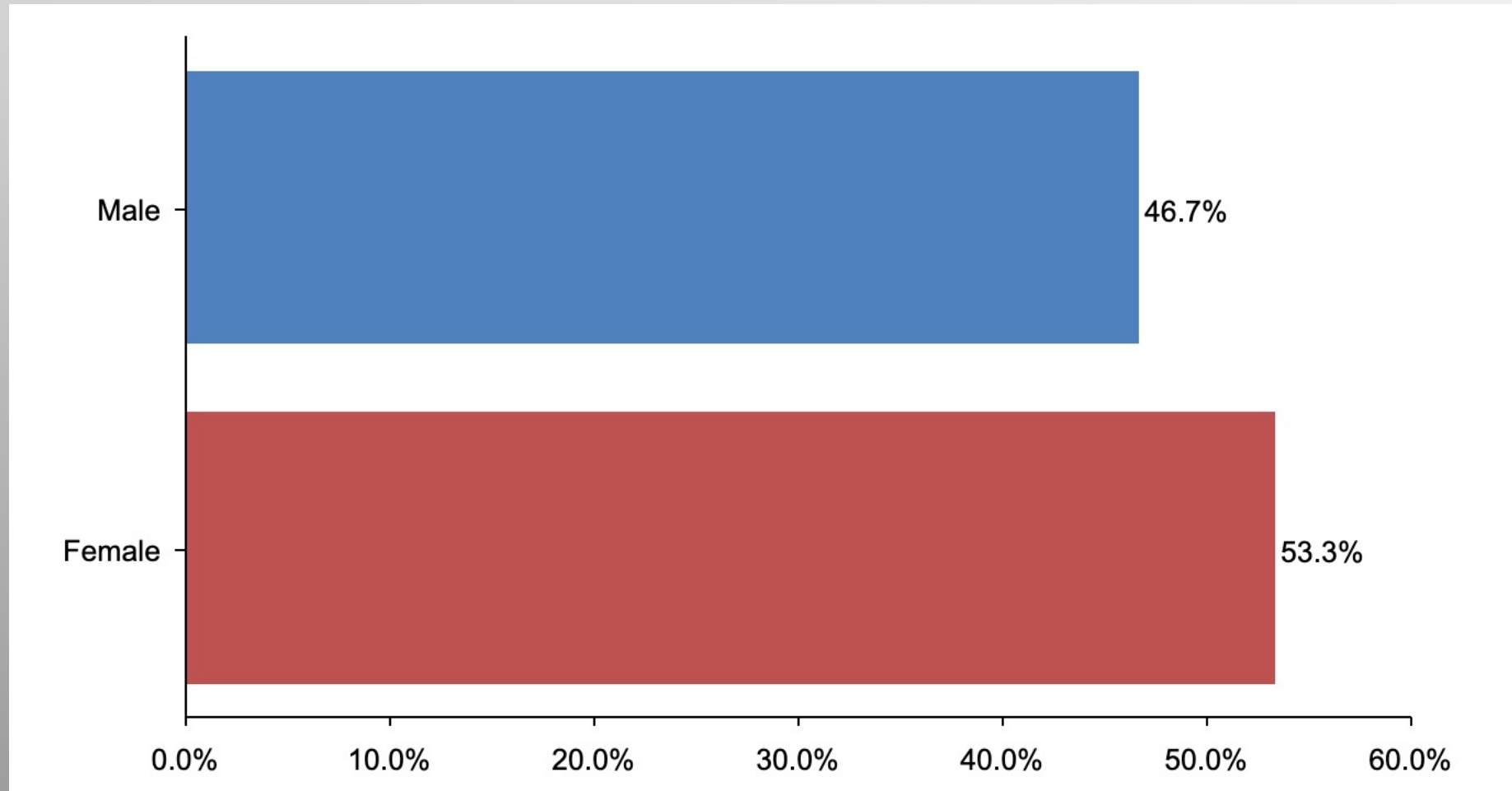
