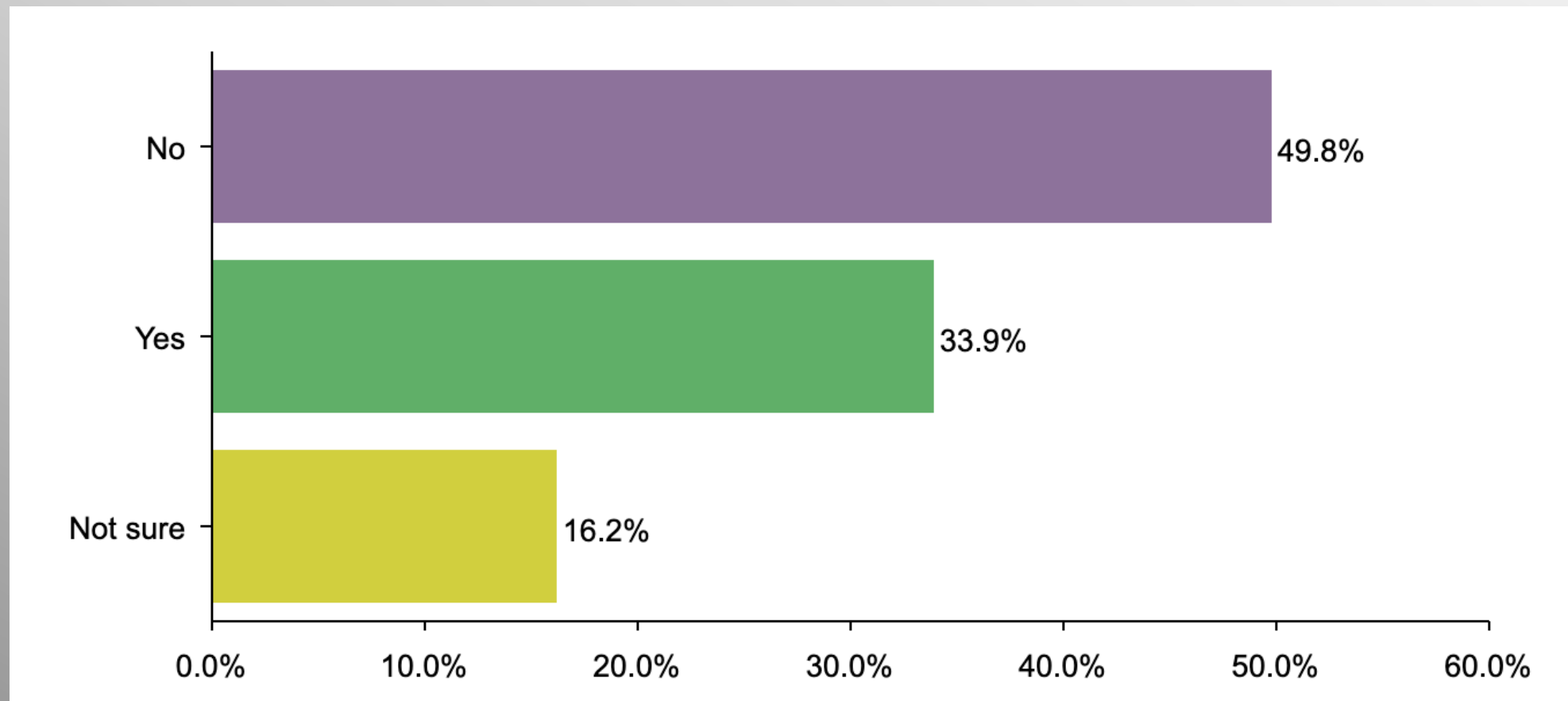
# Nationwide Survey

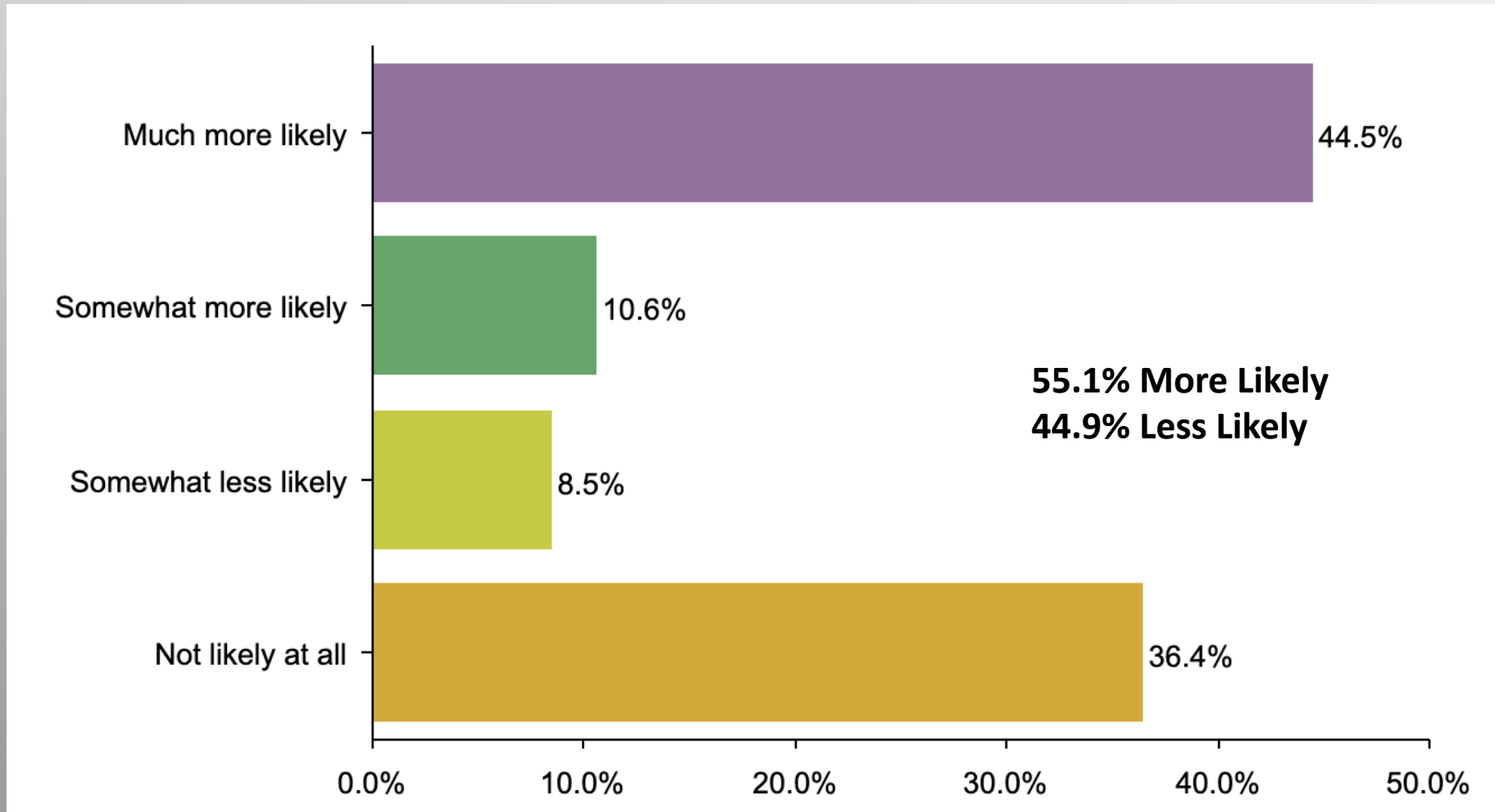

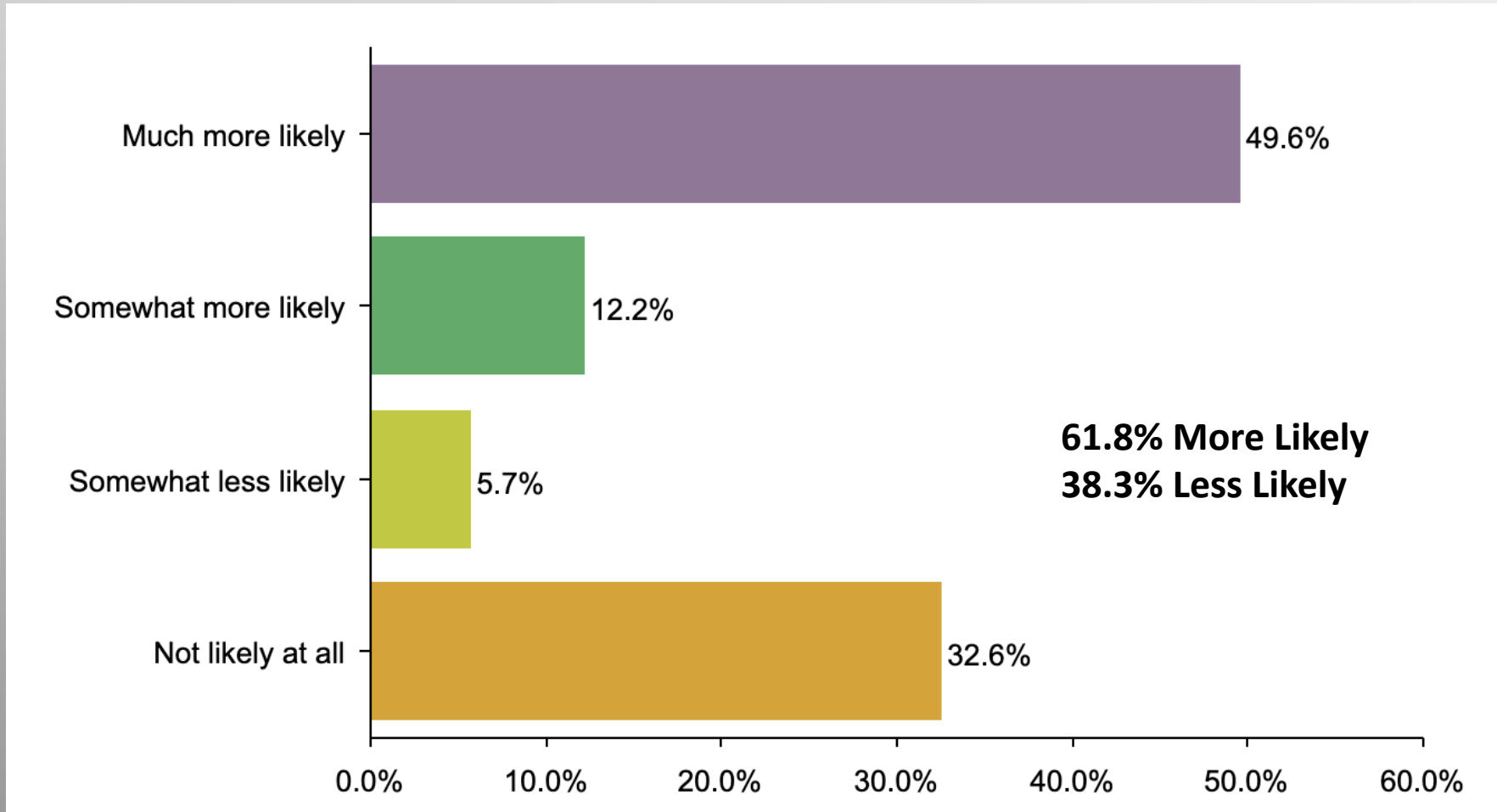
# McCarthy Speech – Parental Bill of Rights

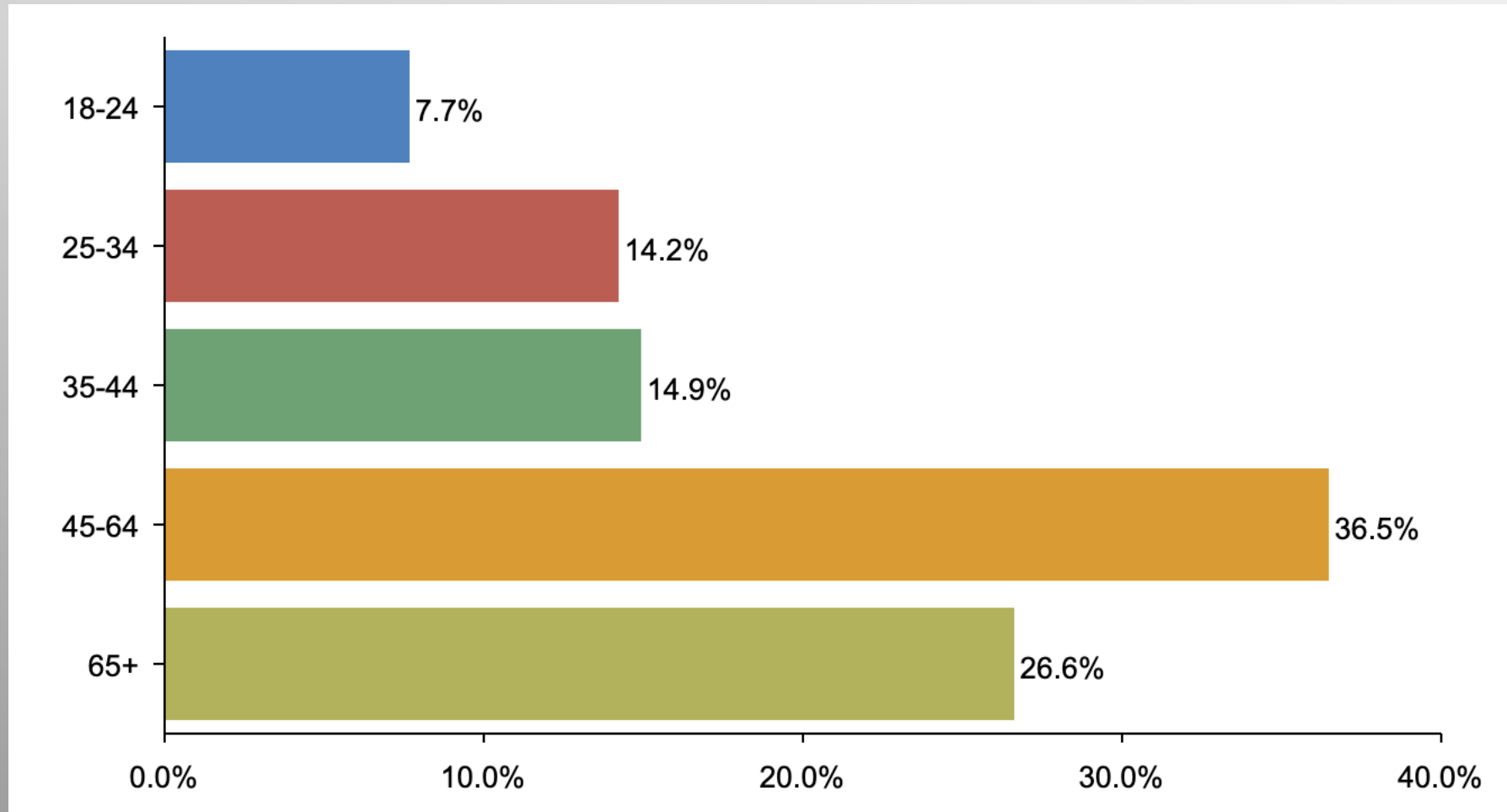

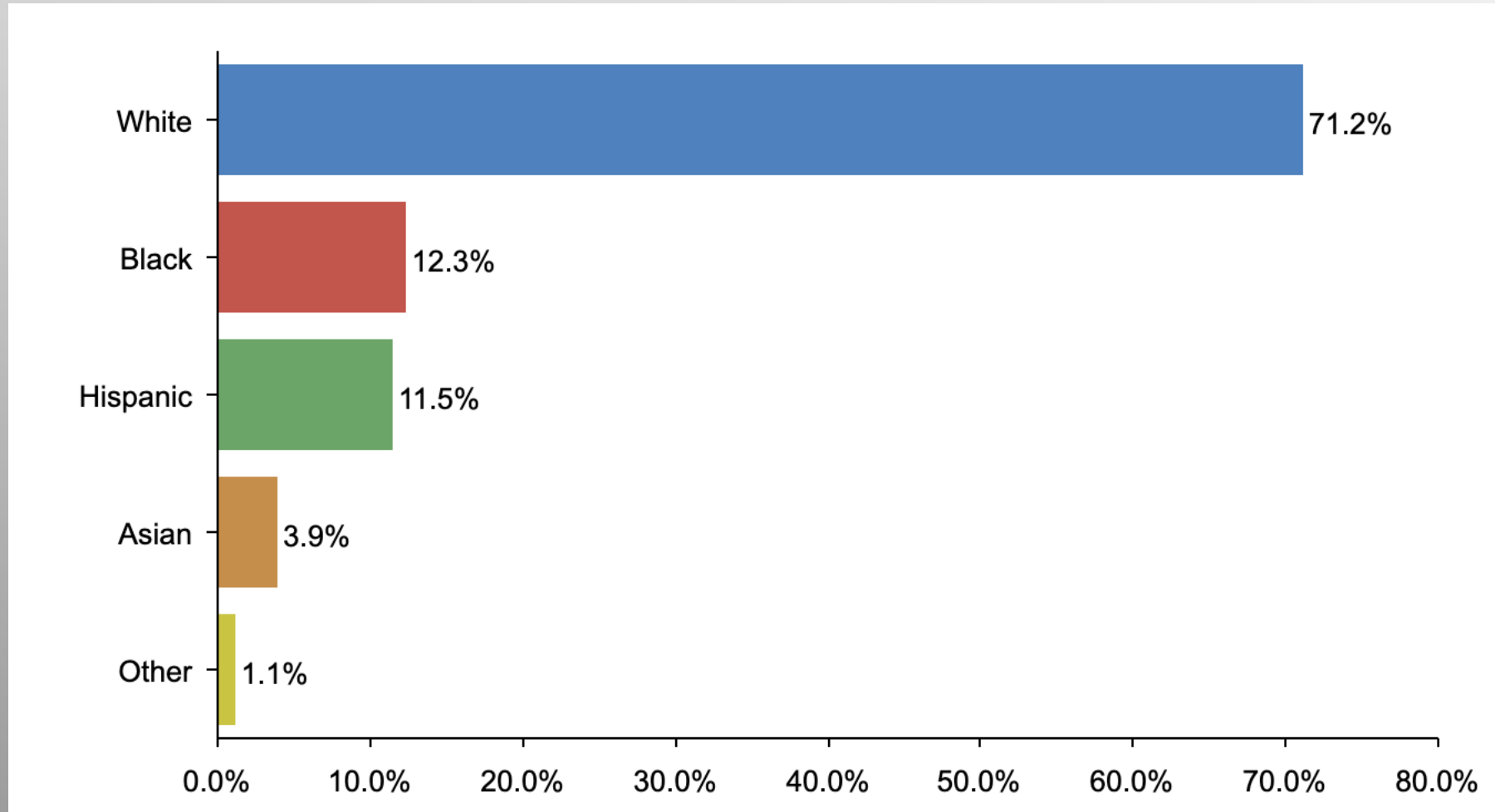

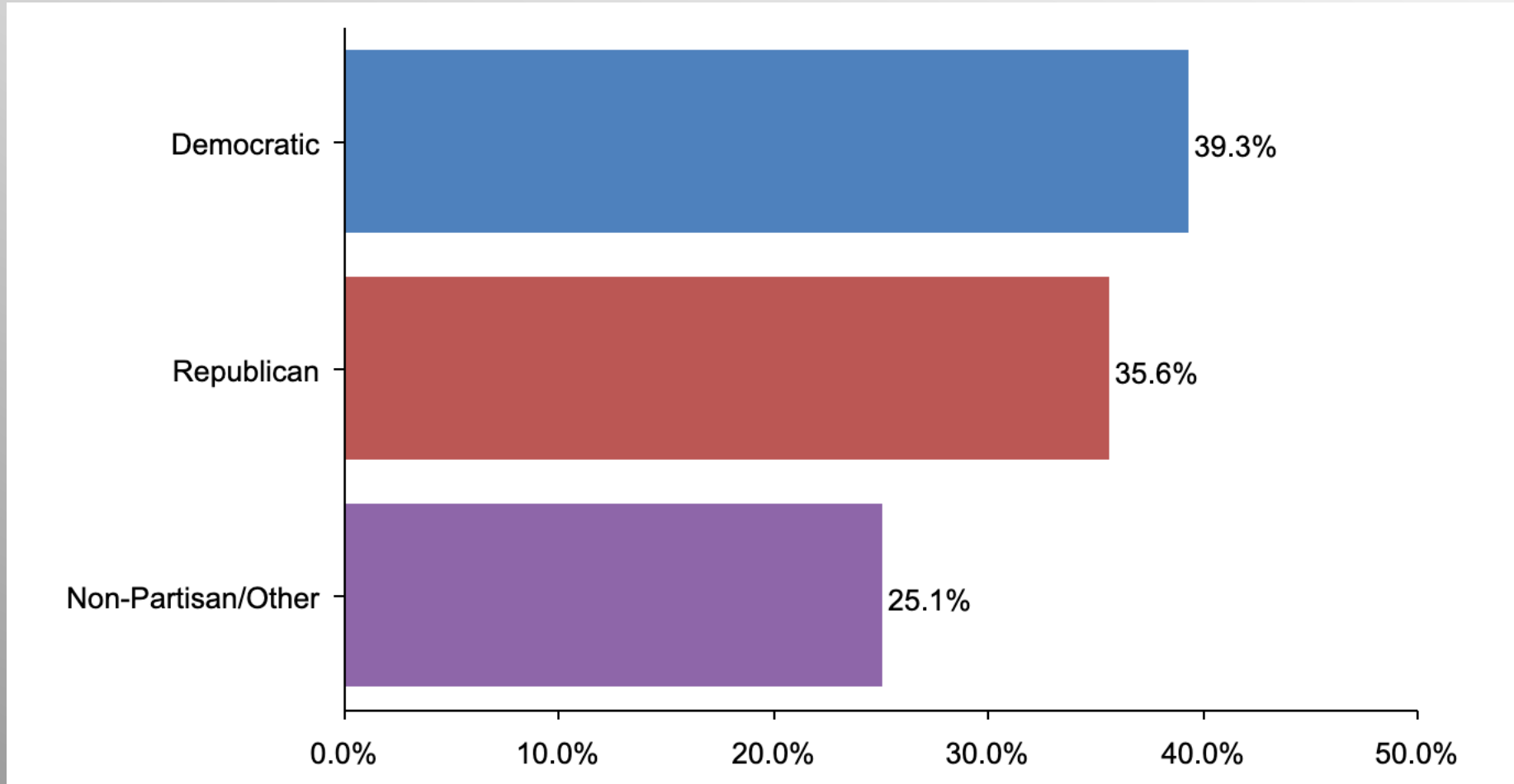

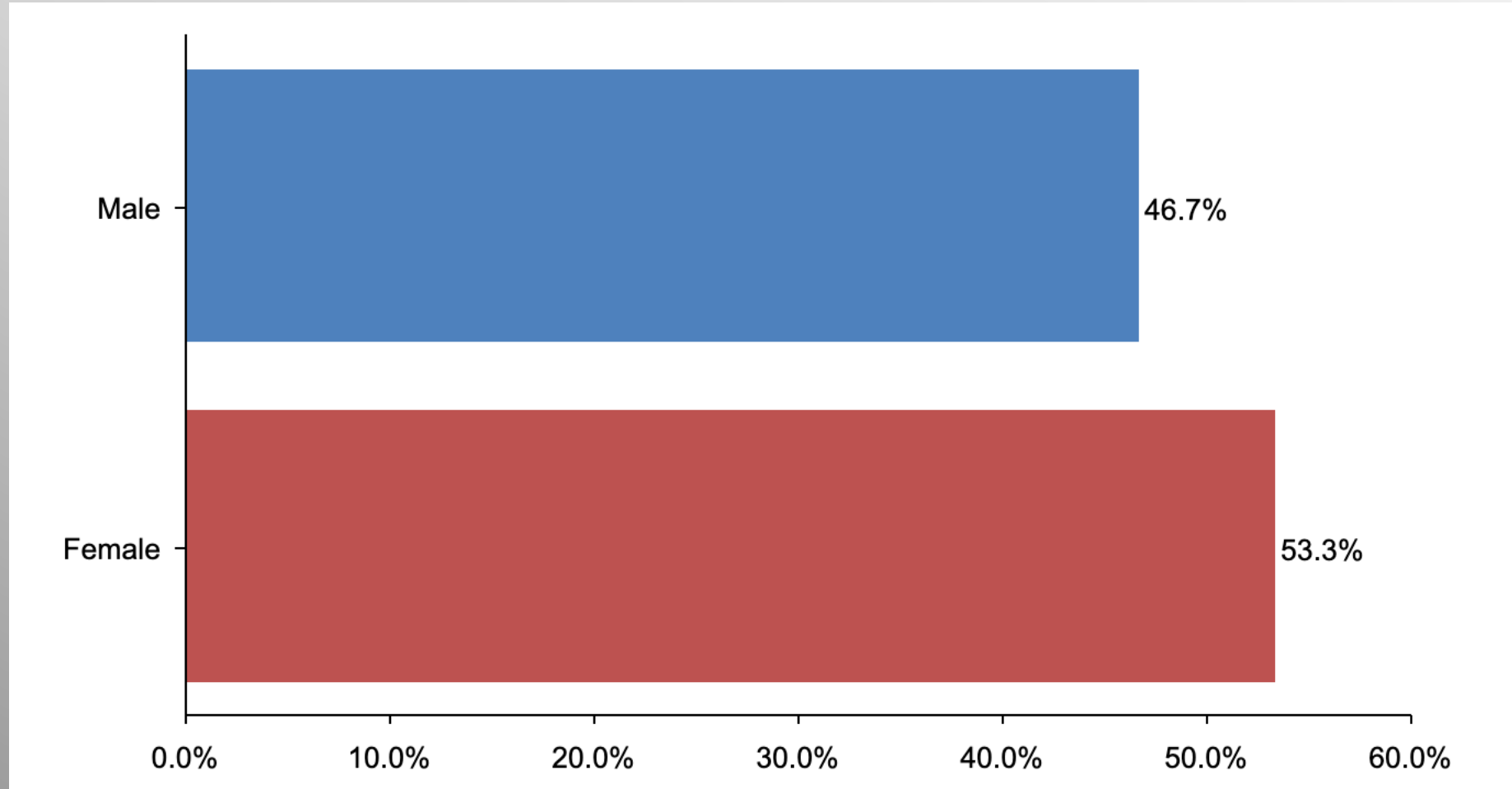
