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



How likely would you be to vote for a candidate who supports policies which prevent police from detaining criminals charged with violent crimes, such as kidnapping and armed robbery?




Crime/Candidate Support (Democrat)

How likely would you be to vote for a candidate who supports policies which prevent police from detaining criminals charged with violent crimes, such as kidnapping and armed robbery?




CONVENTION of STATES ACTION




Crime/Candidate Support (GOP)

How likely would you be to vote for a candidate who supports policies which prevent police from detaining criminals charged with violent crimes, such as kidnapping and armed robbery?




Crime/Candidate Support (No Party/Other)


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
Age Participation




Ethnicity Participation
