


# Nationwide Survey



*Due to the Biden family's business relationships with China, do you believe President Biden has a conflict of interest when responding to China's aggressive actions against the U.S.?*




# Biden/China (Democrat)

*Due to the Biden family's business relationships with China, do you believe President Biden has a conflict of interest when responding to China's aggressive actions against the U.S.?*




# Biden/China (GOP)
















