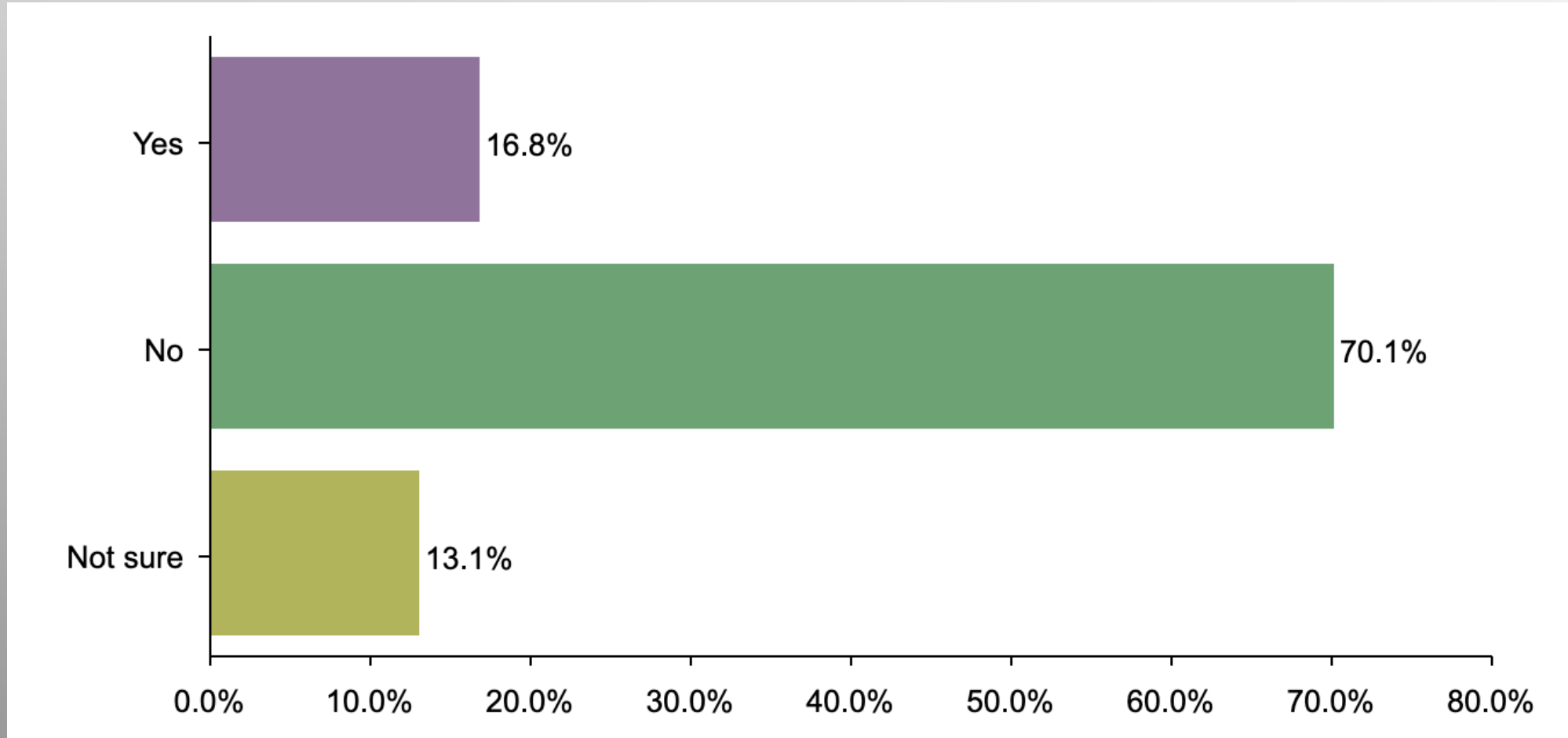

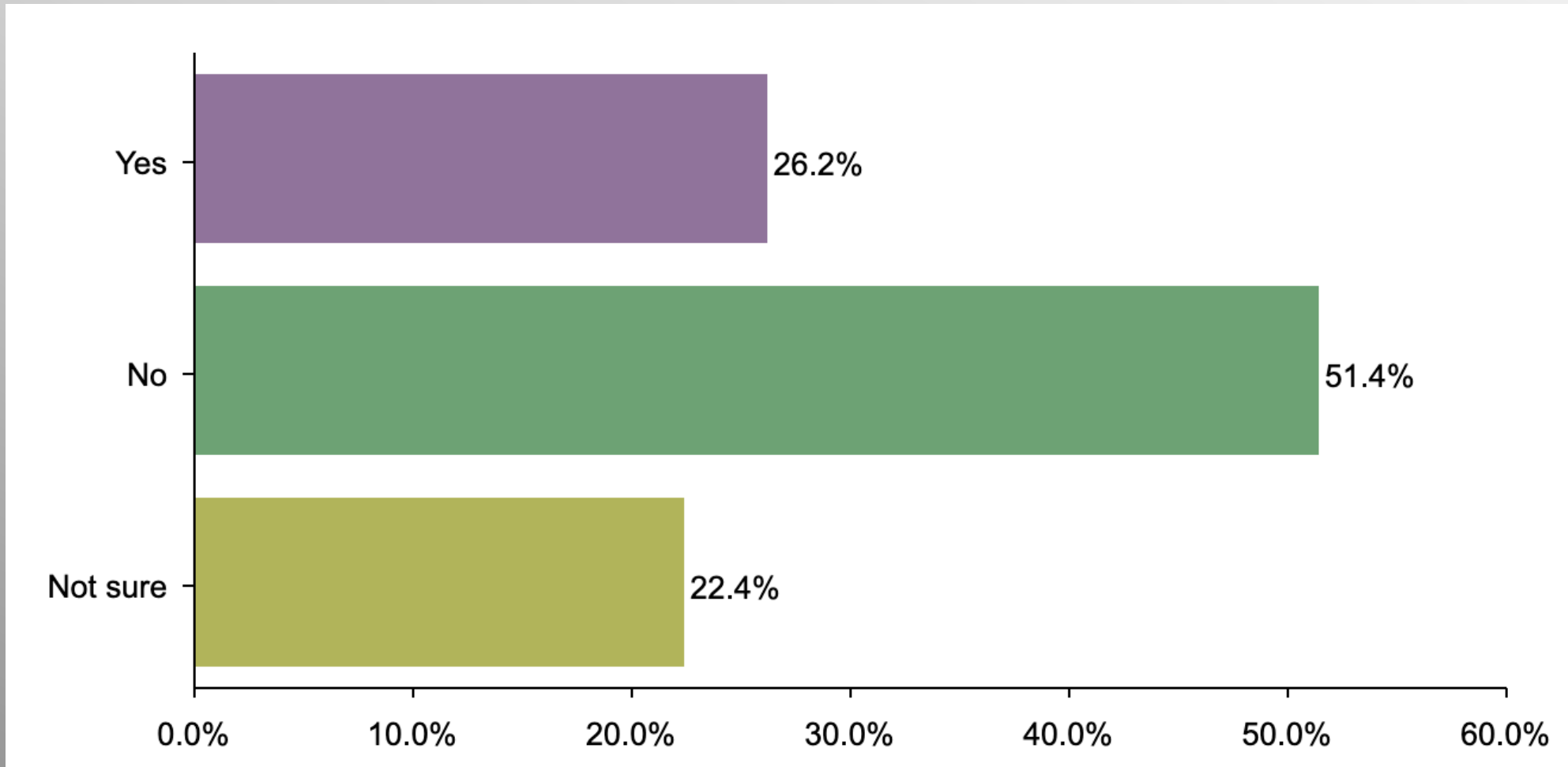

Do you think that the FDIC should use its reserve fund to pay some bank depositors millions of dollars each, when they were only insured up to \$250,000 per account?



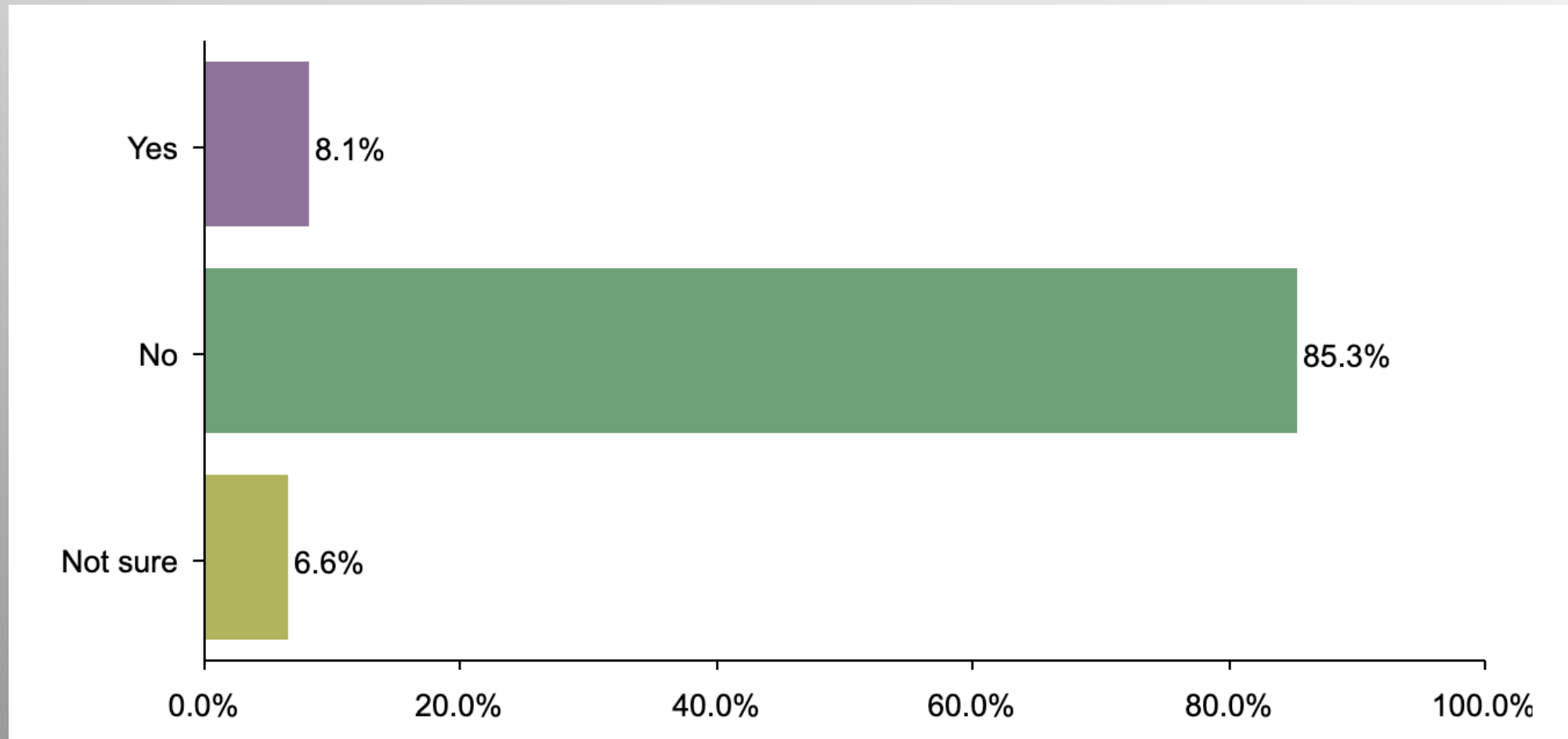
FDIC Reserve (Democrat)

Do you think that the FDIC should use its reserve fund to pay some bank depositors millions of dollars each, when they were only insured up to \$250,000 per account?



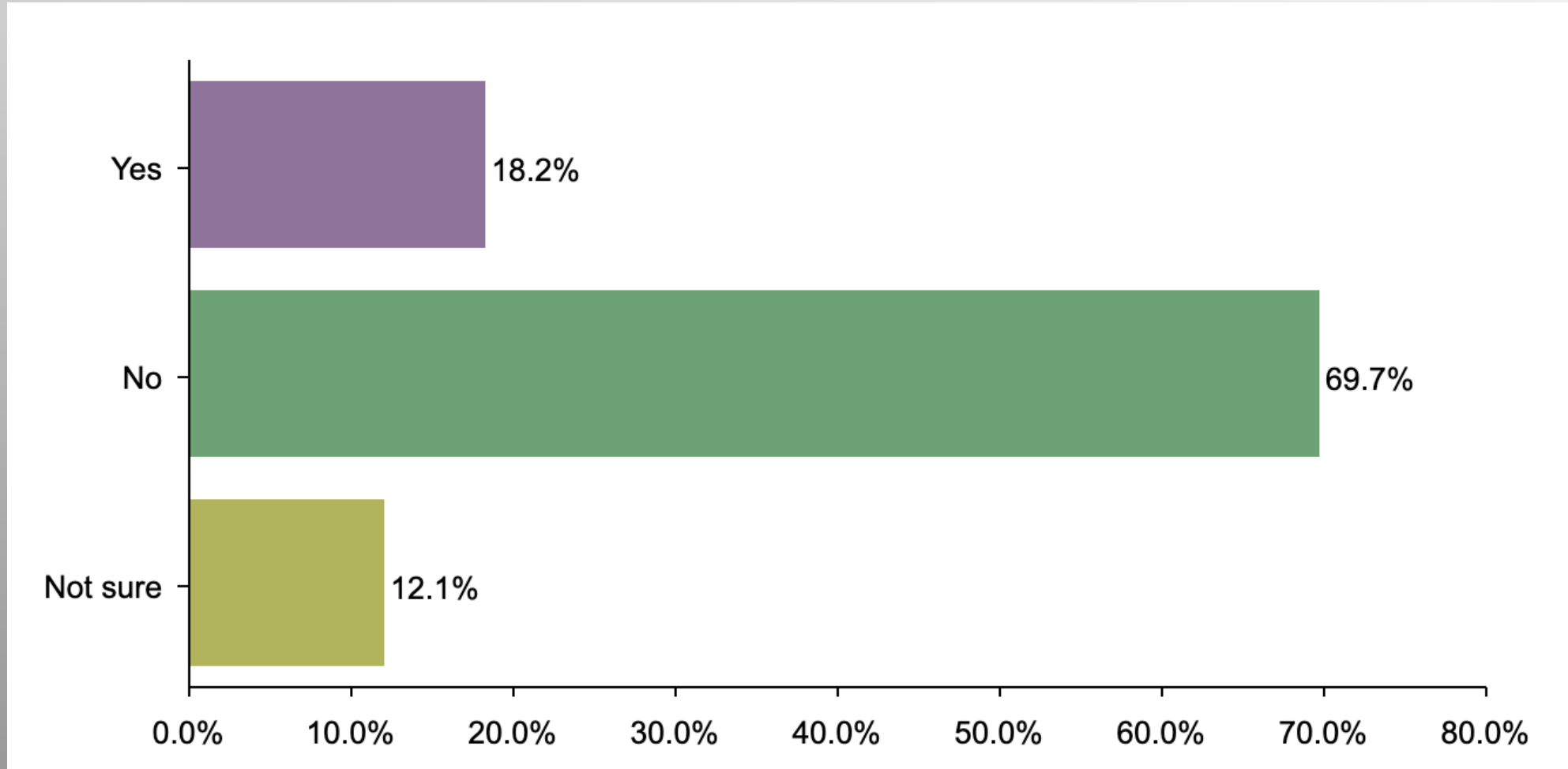
FDIC Reserve (GOP)

Do you think that the FDIC should use its reserve fund to pay some bank depositors millions of dollars each, when they were only insured up to \$250,000 per account?

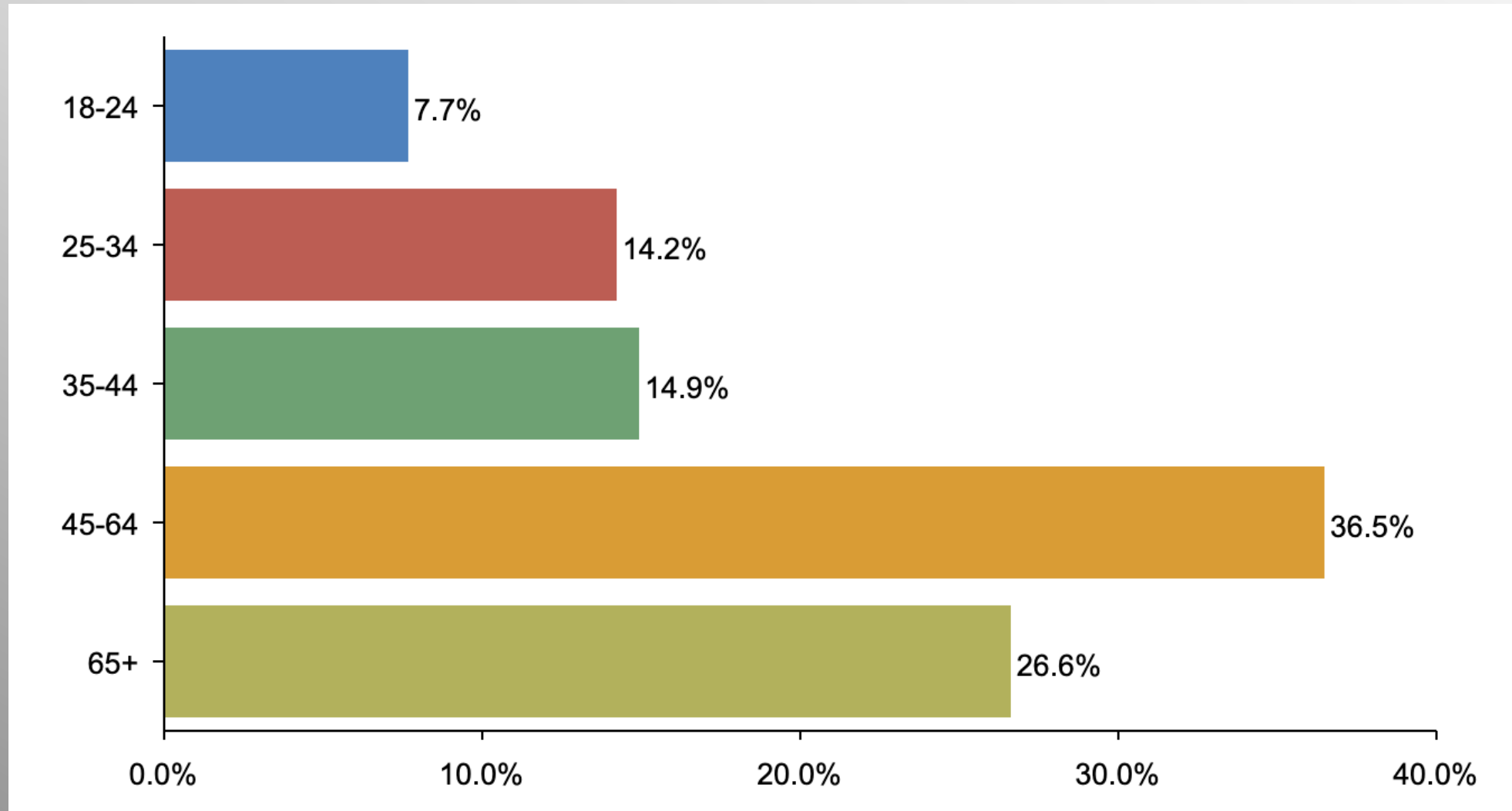

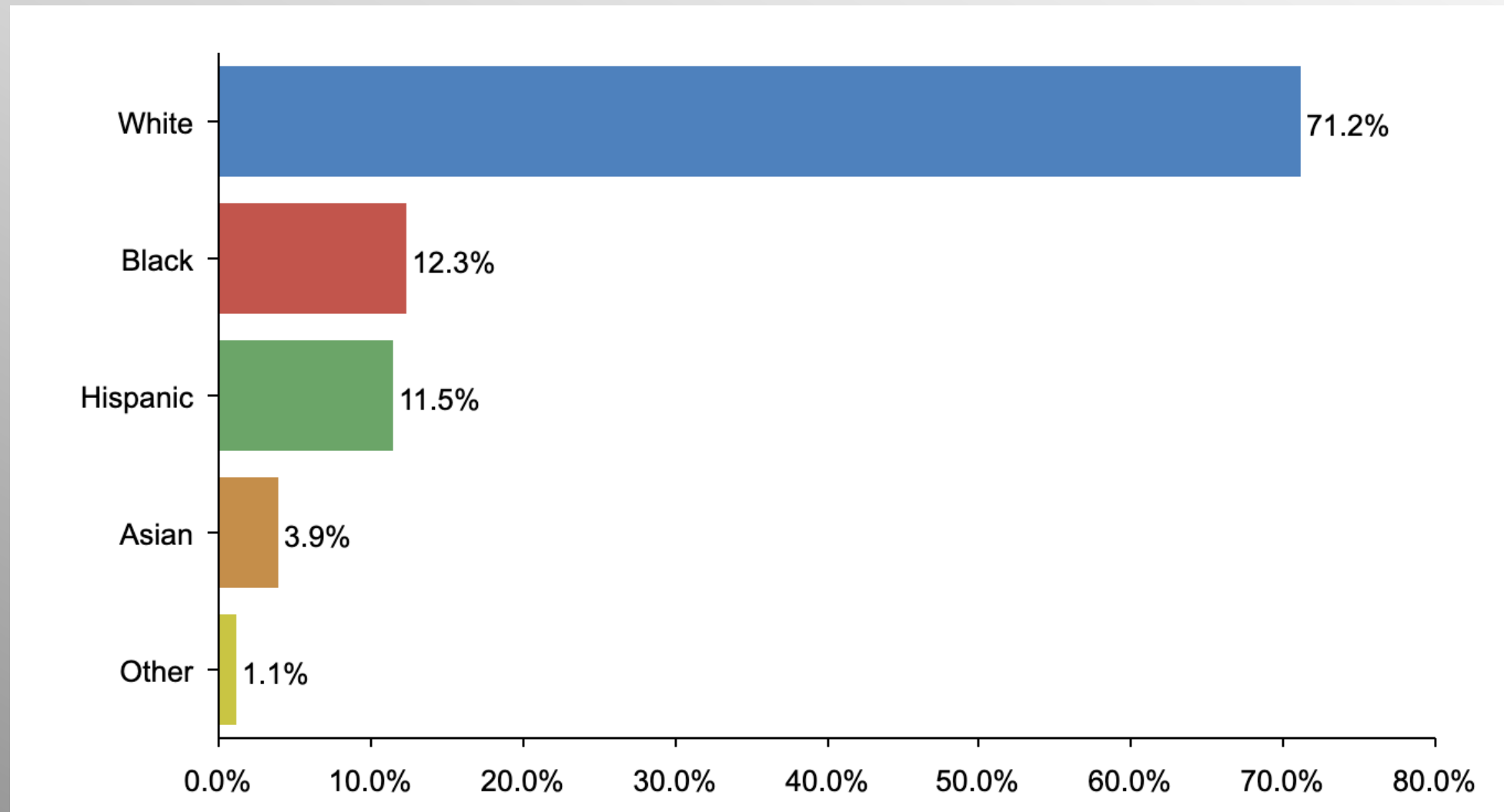
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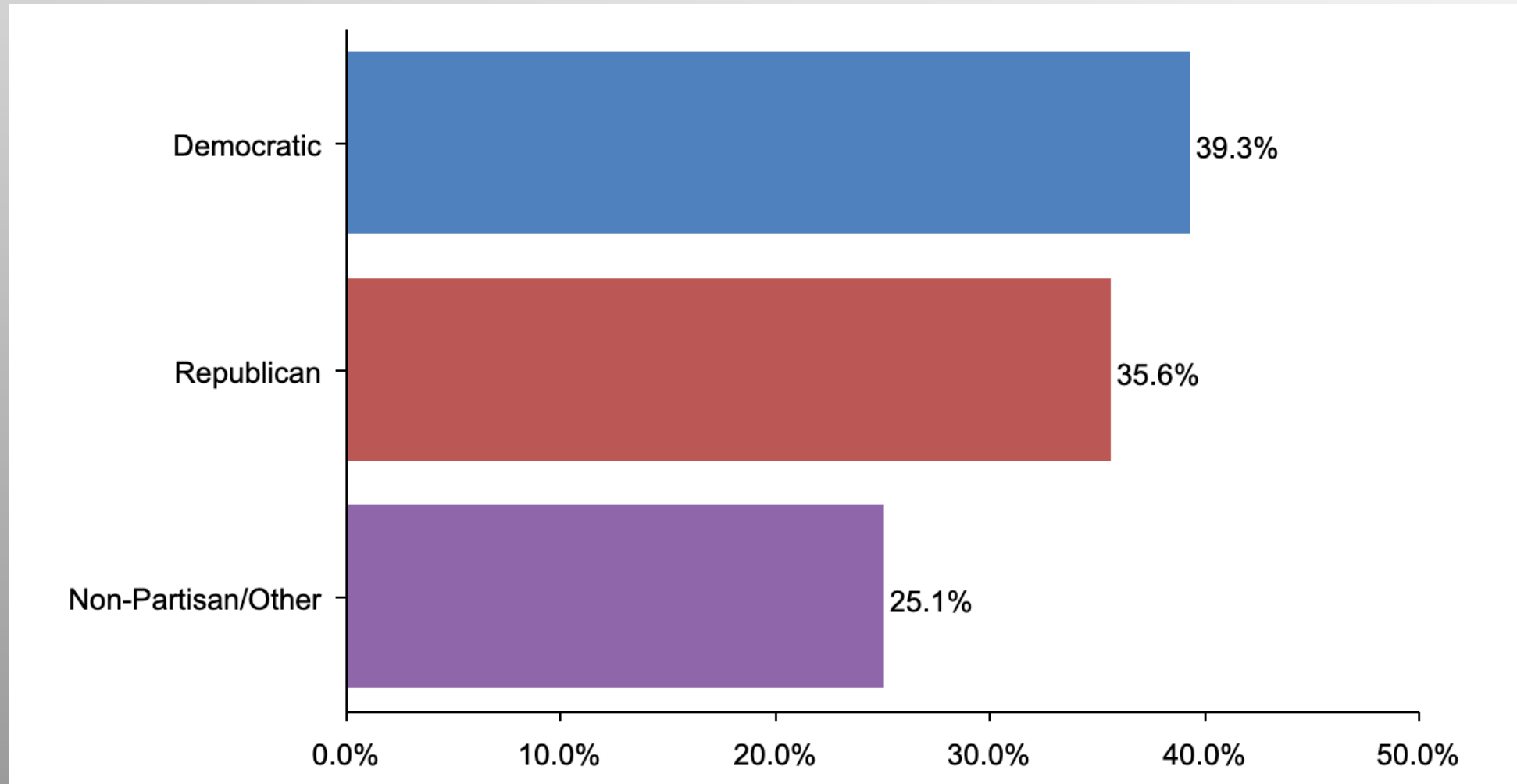
Age Participation



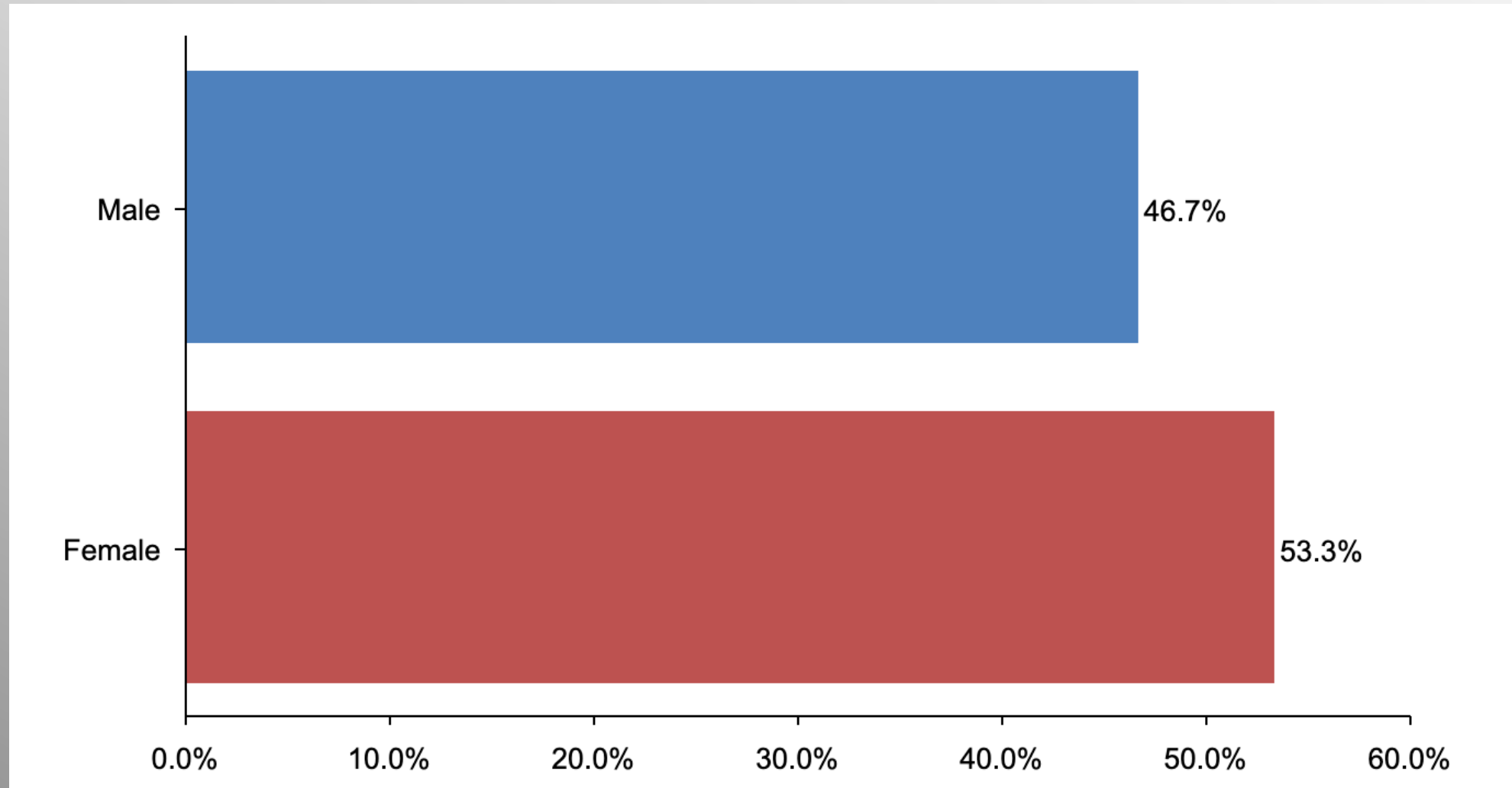
Ethnicity Participation
