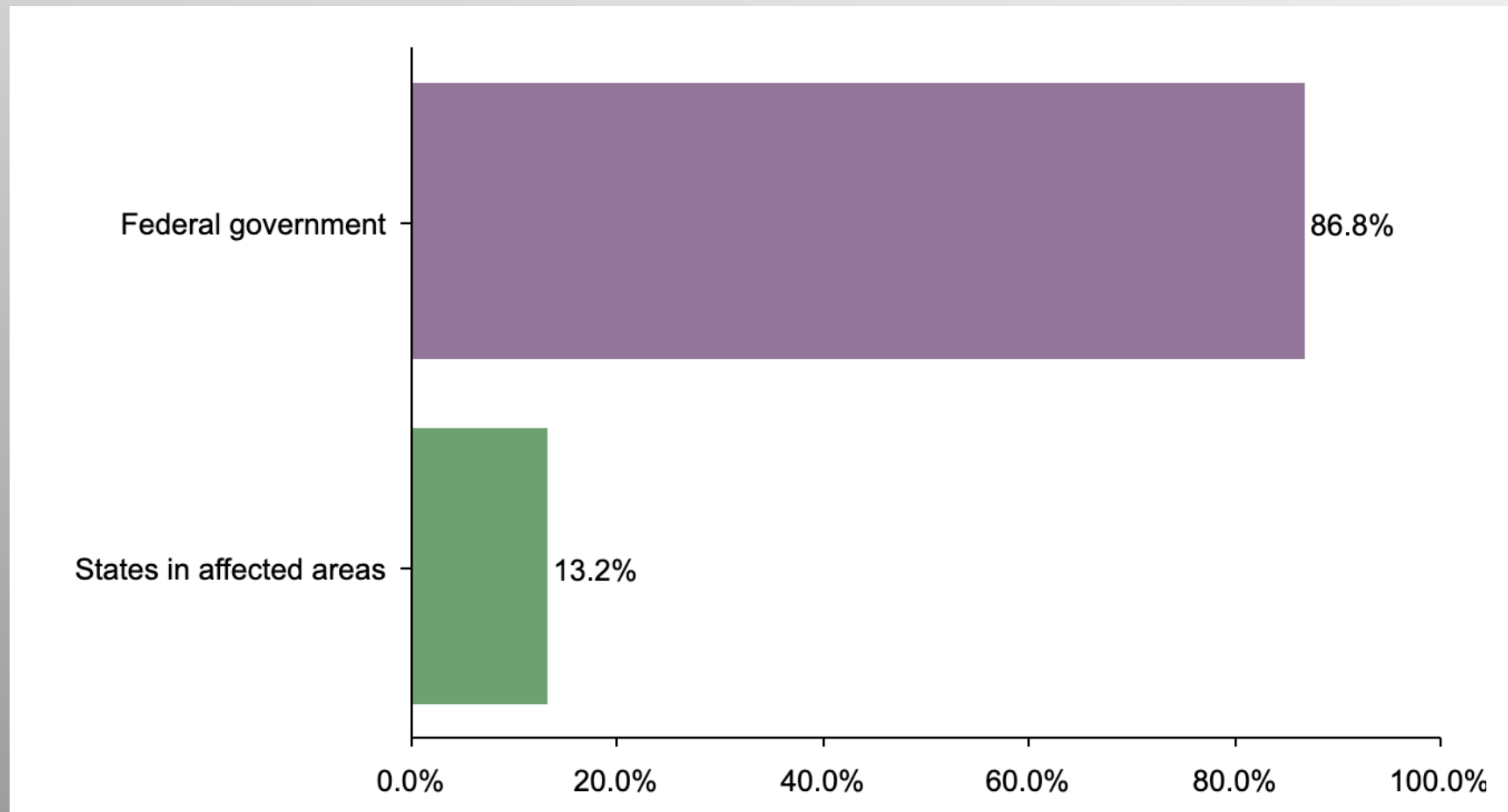

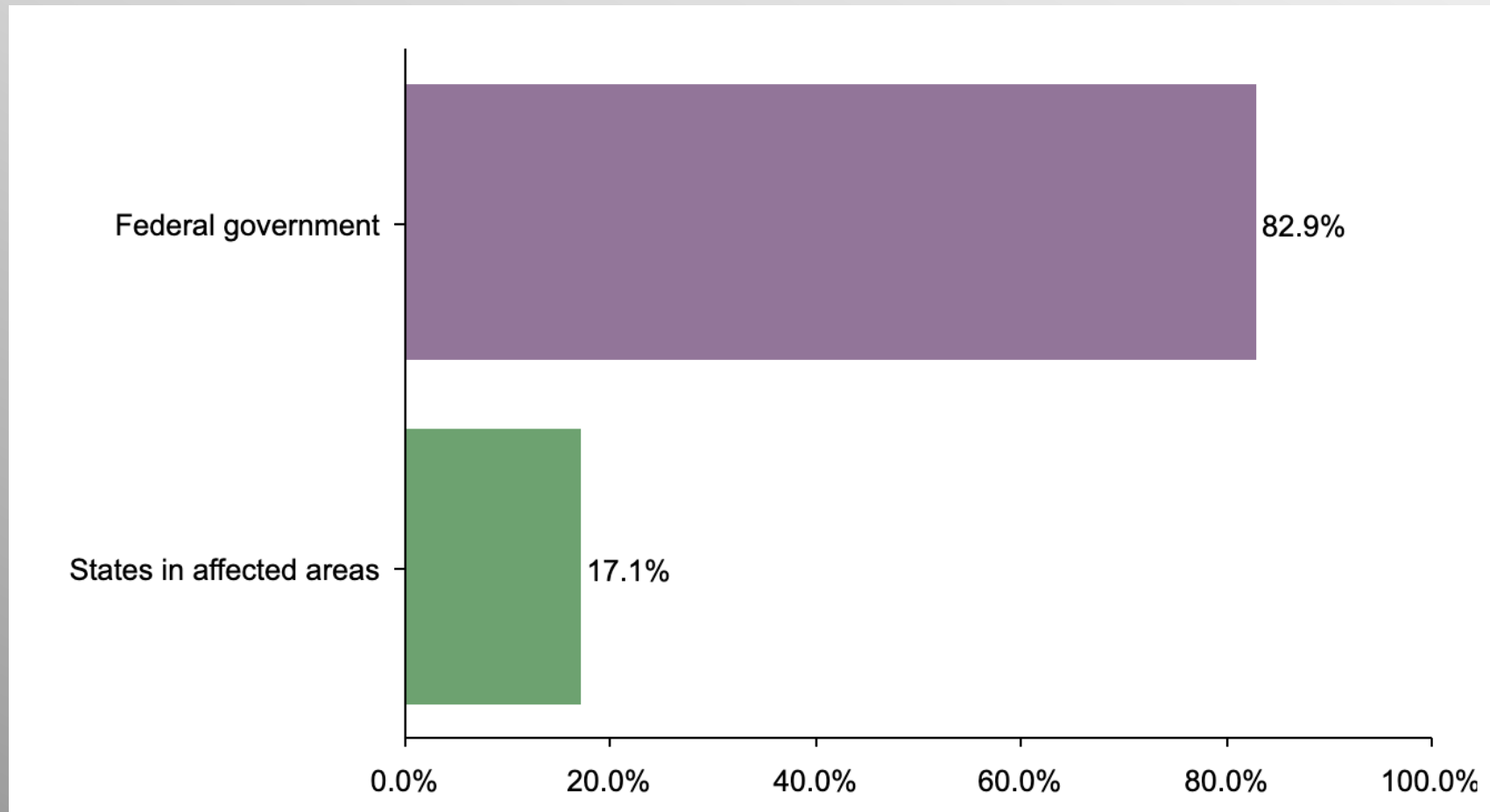

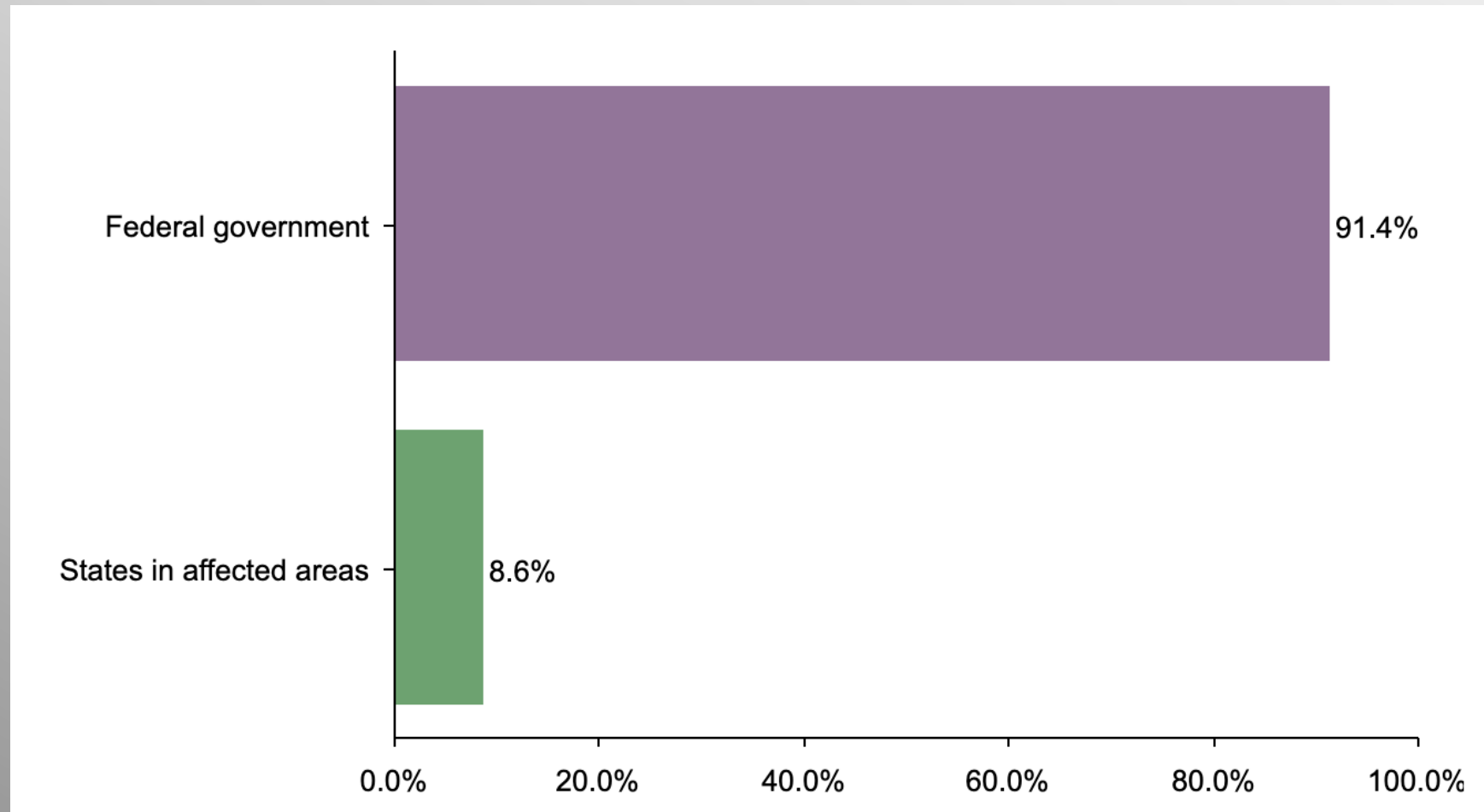

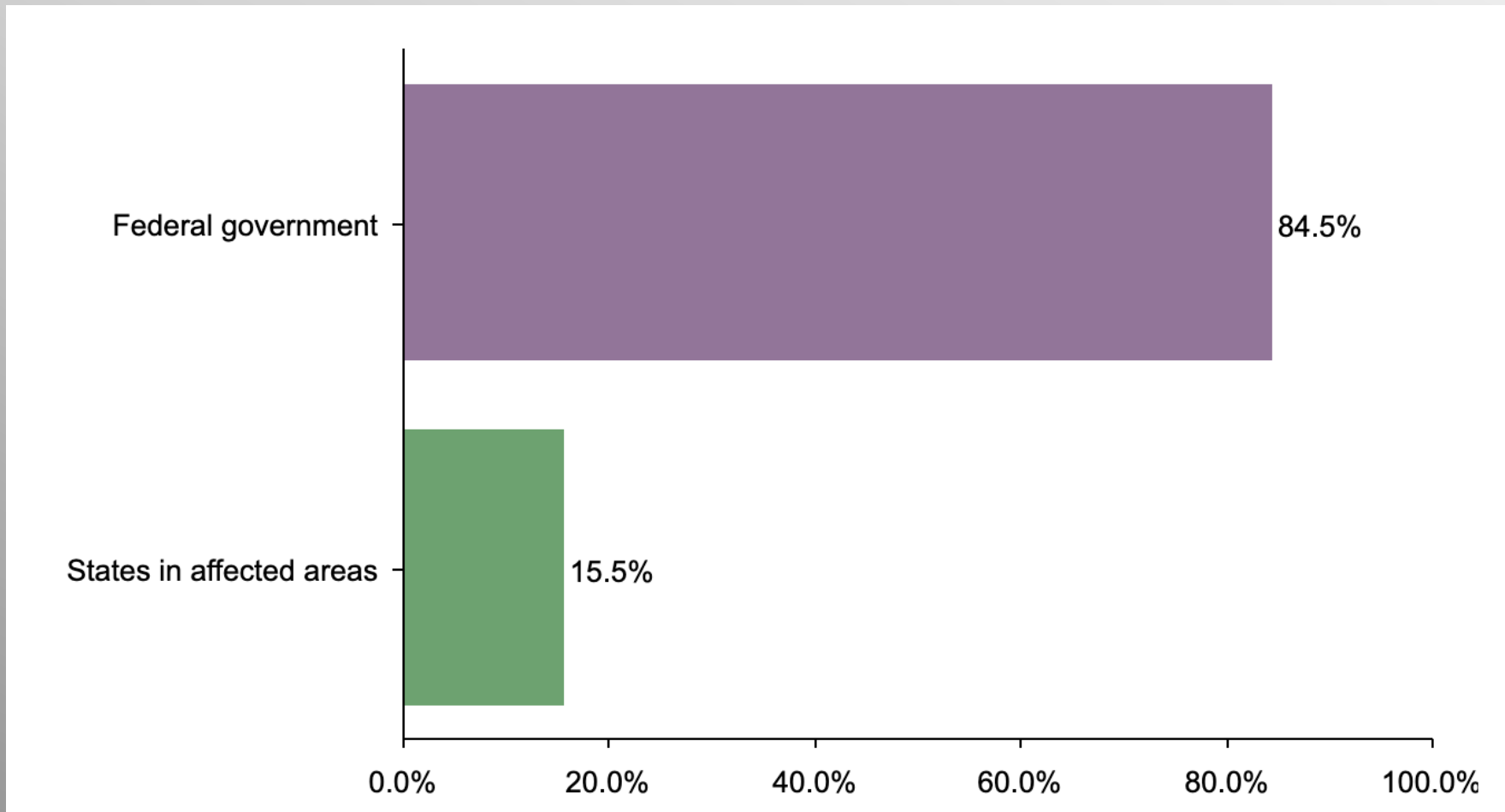

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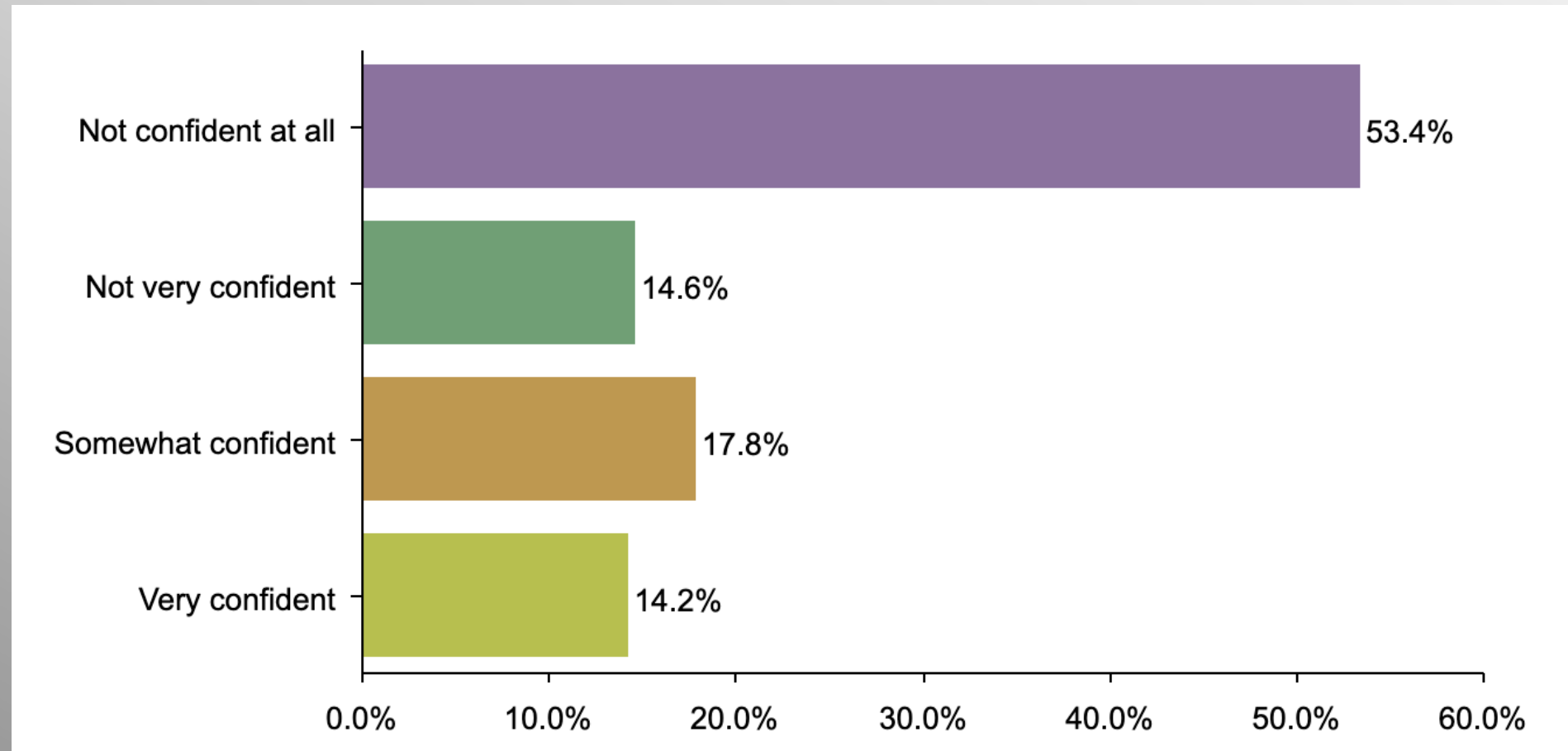

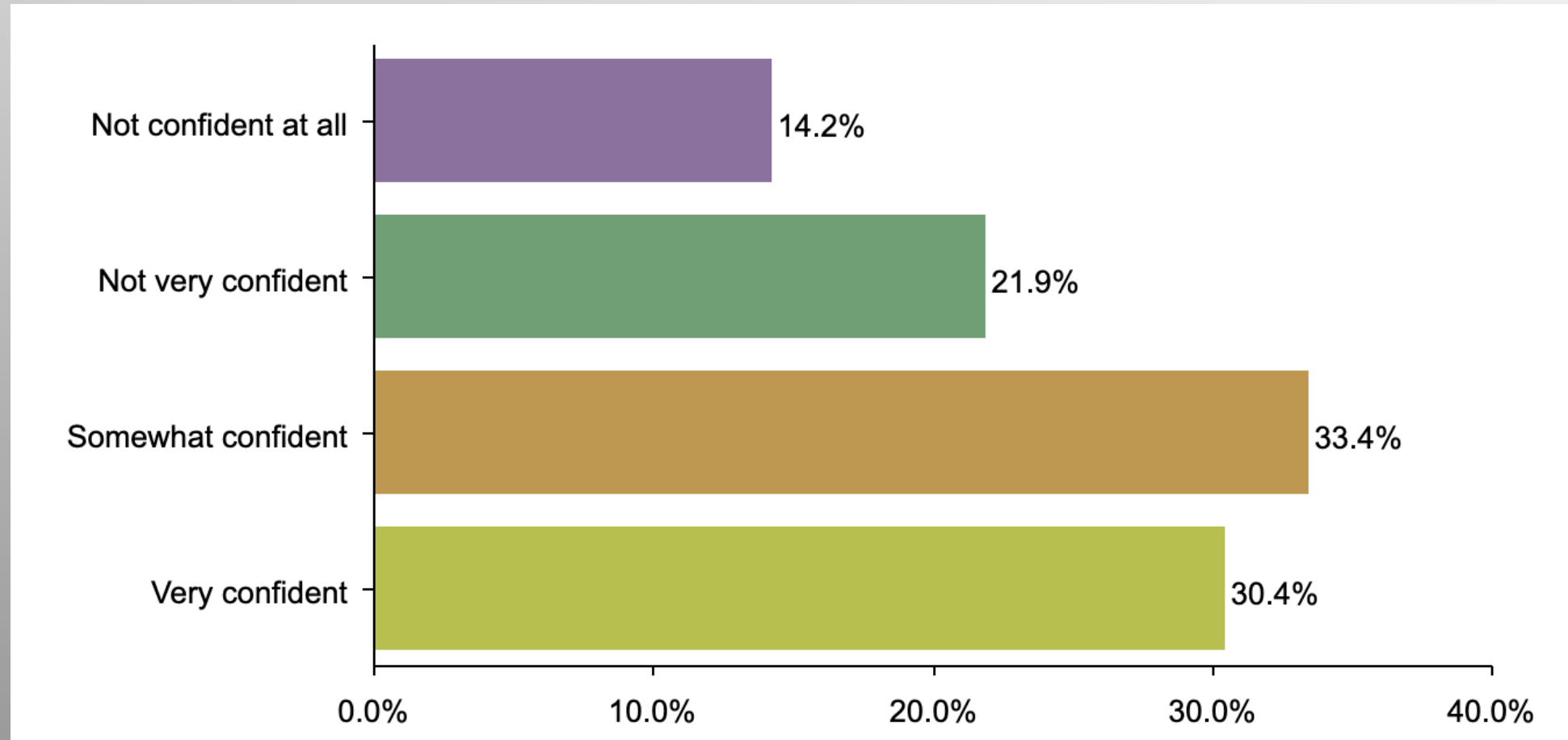

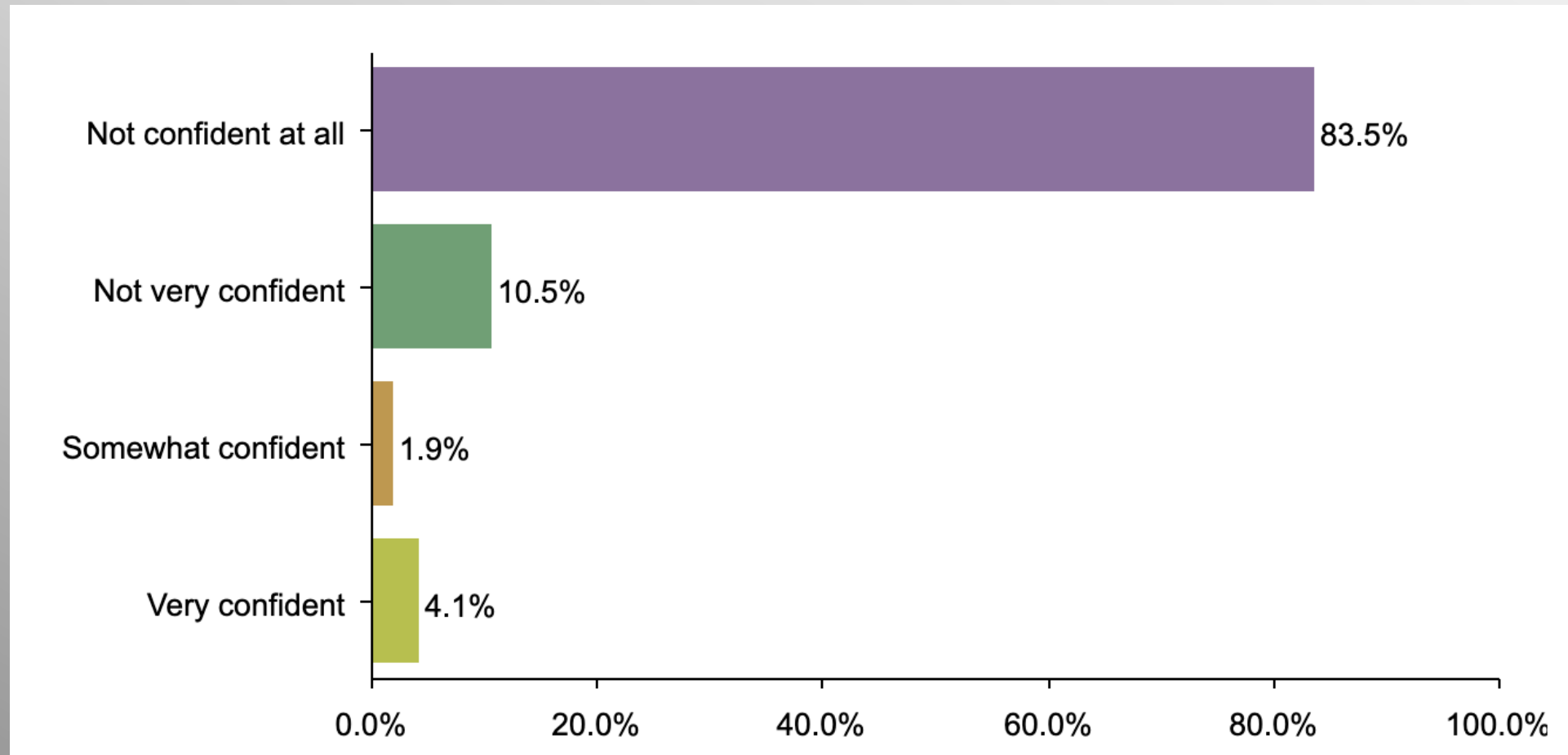

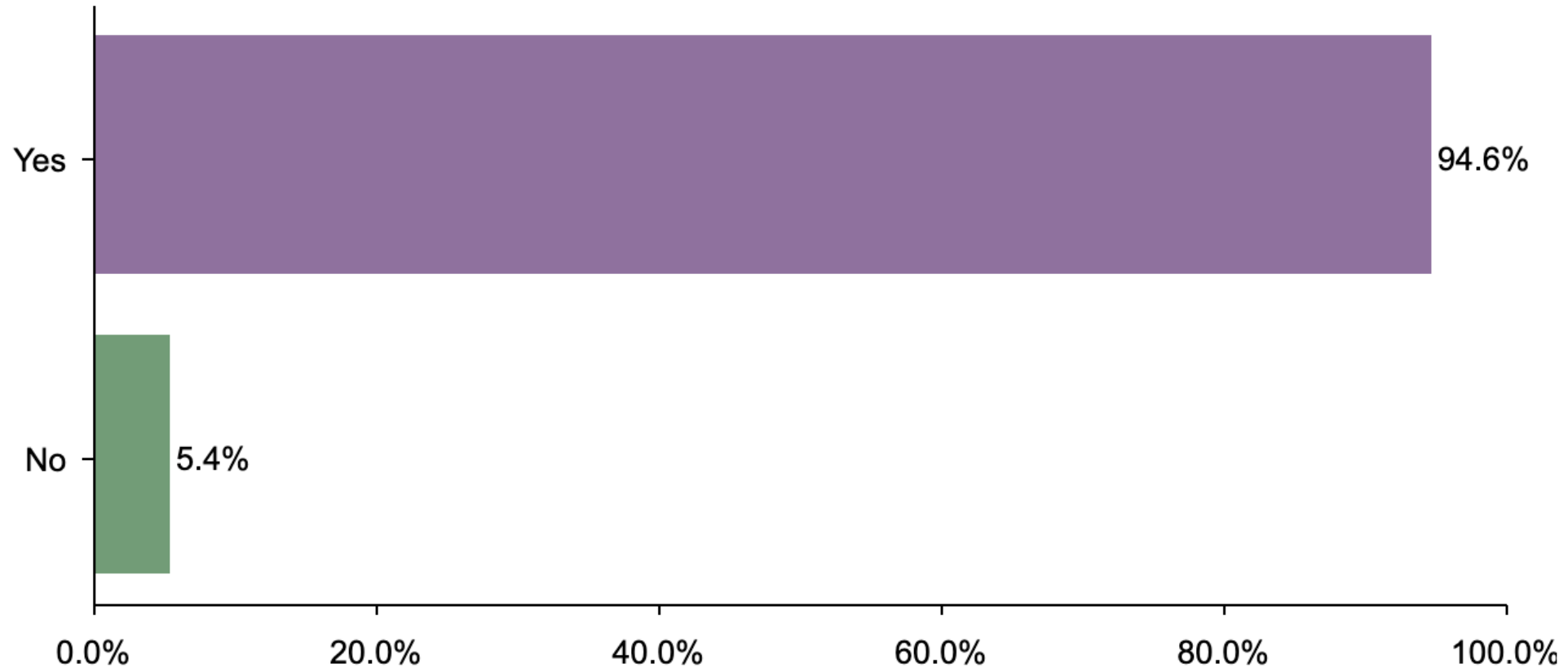

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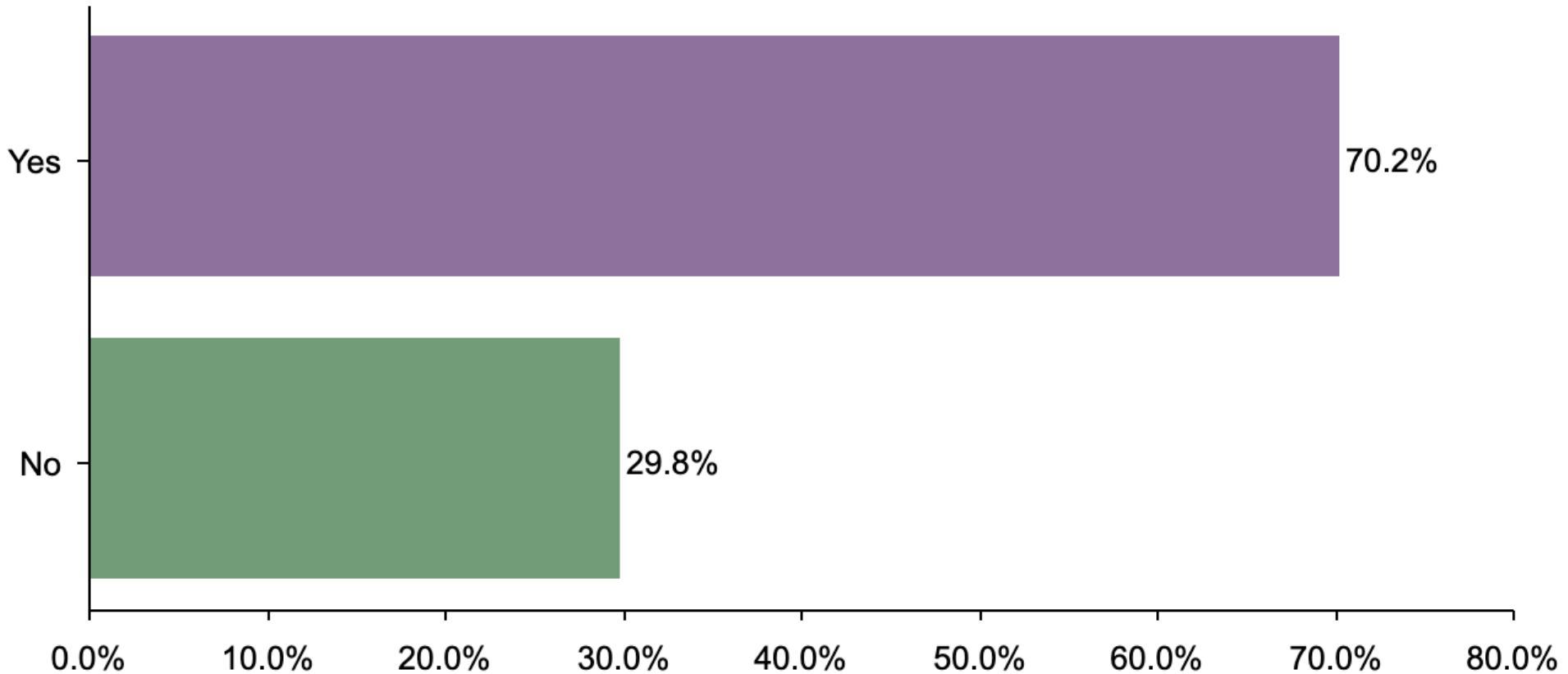
States' Rights (GOP)

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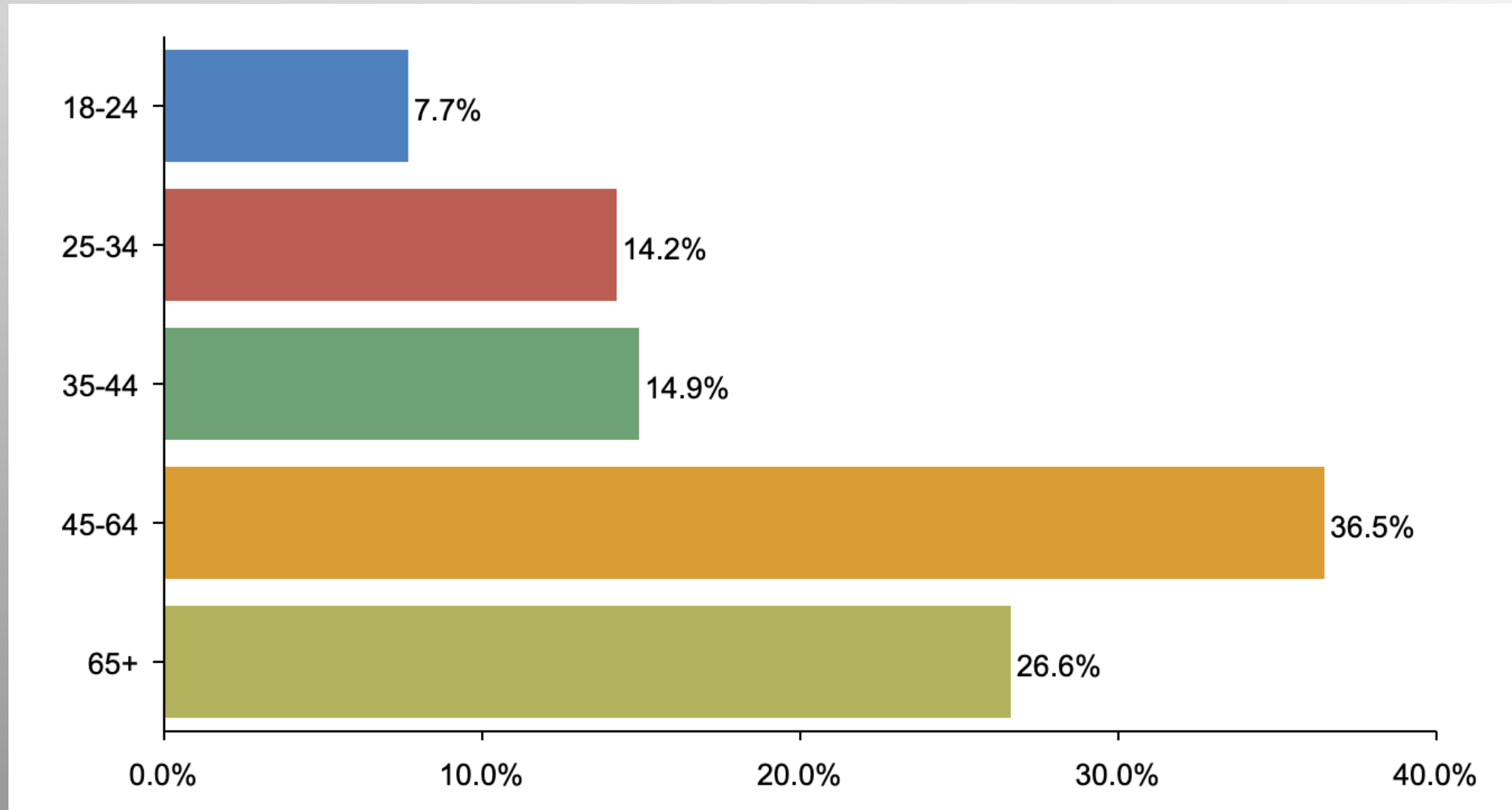


States' Rights (No Party/Other)

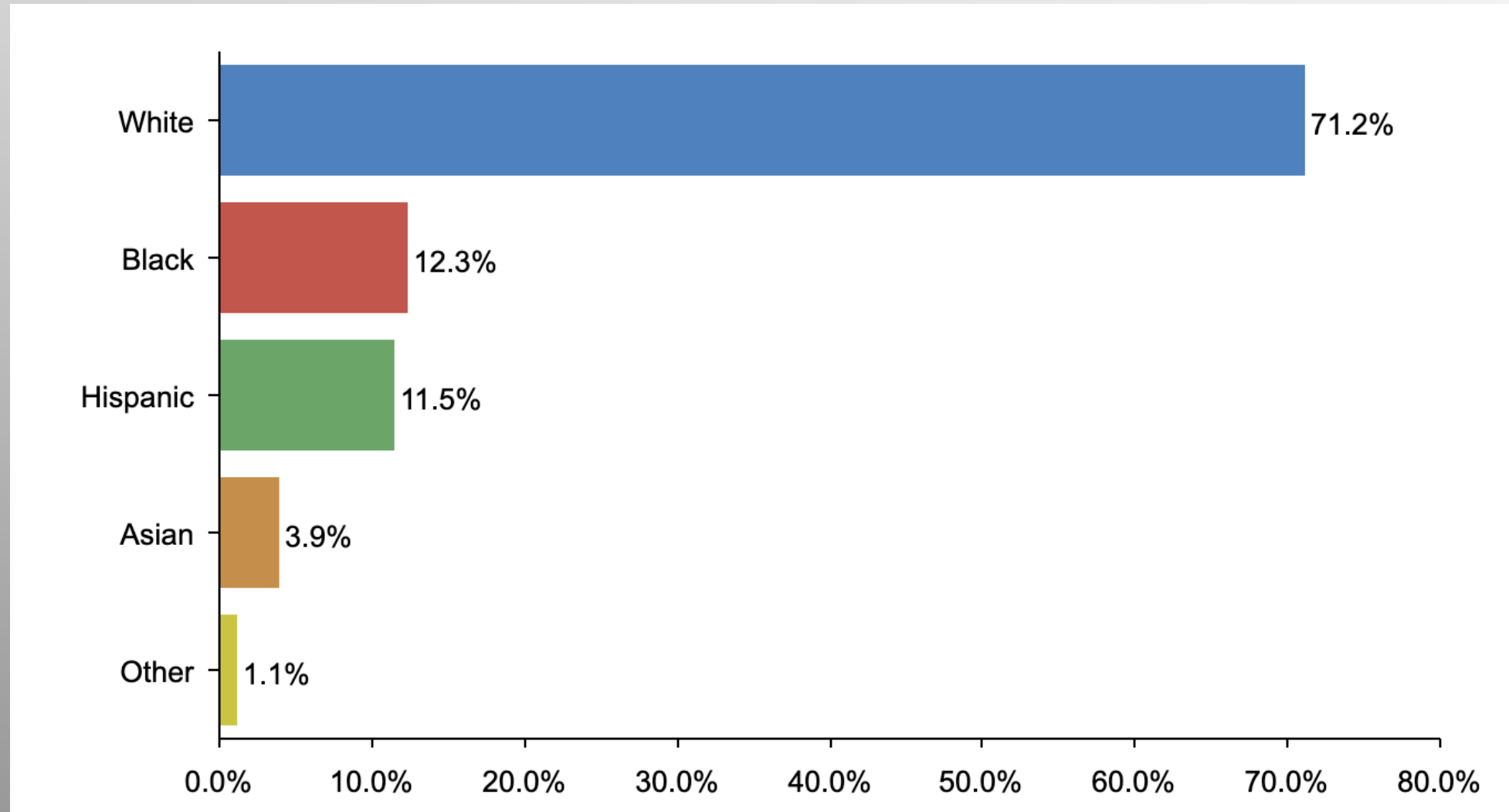
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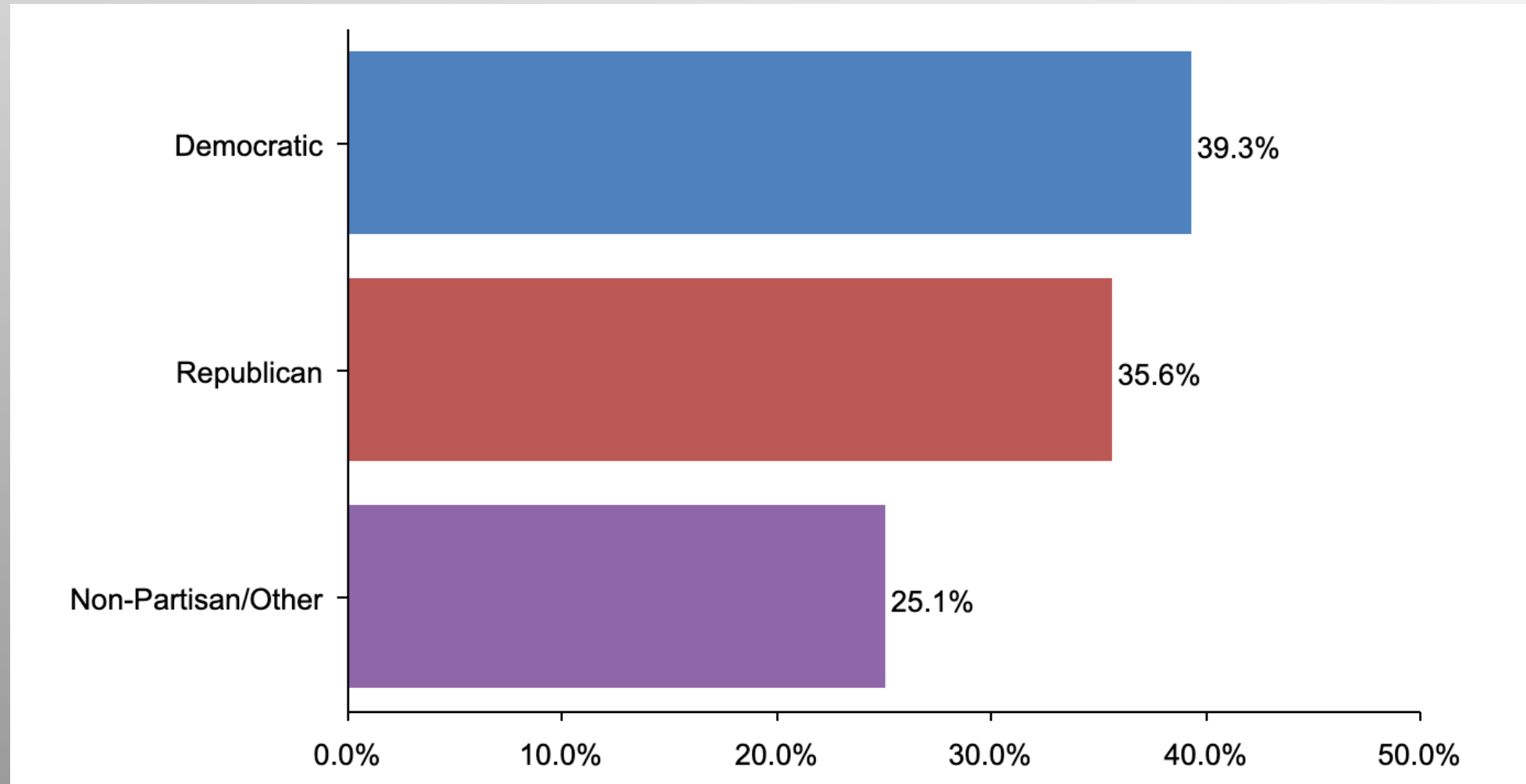

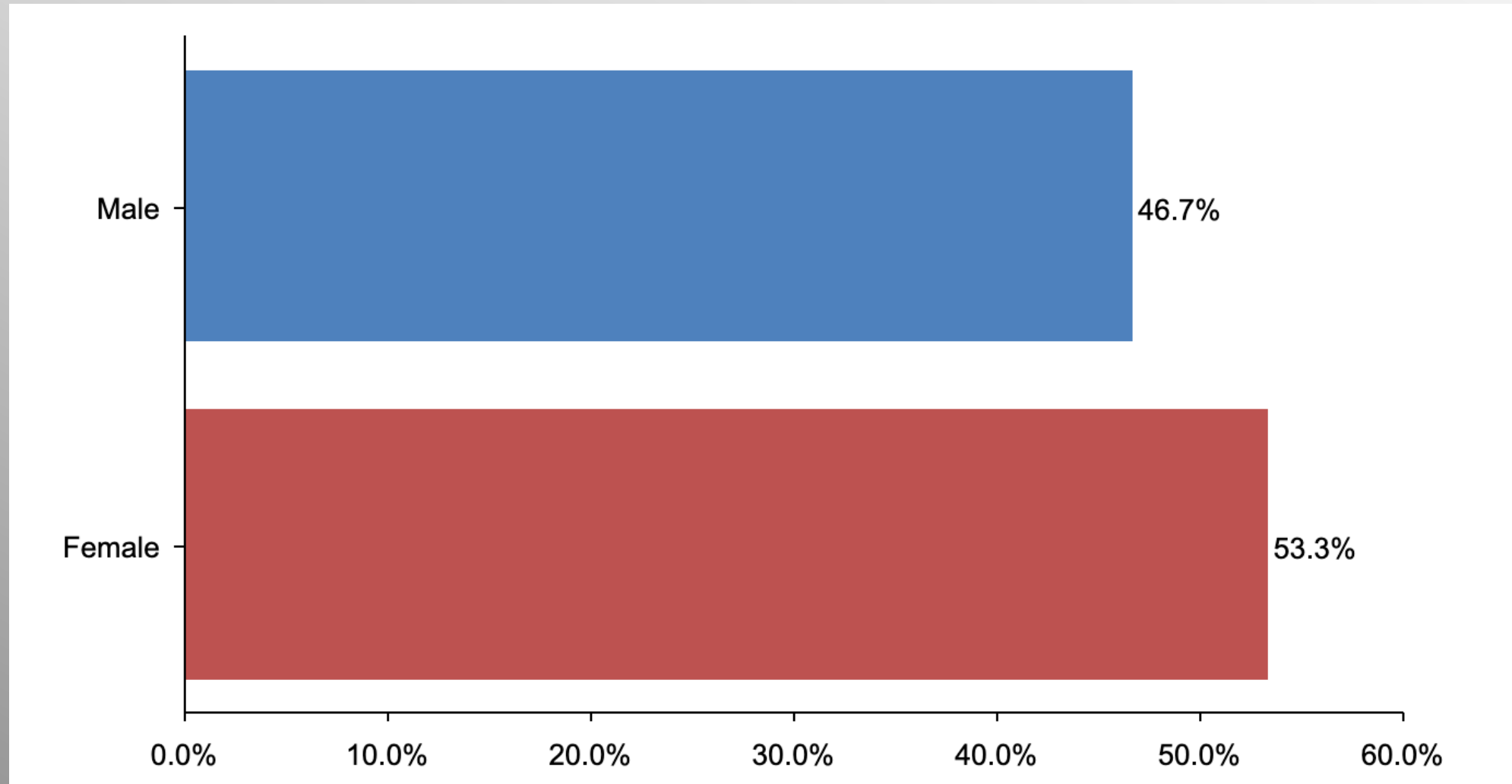
Ethnicity Participation
