1. How aware are you with the Make America Healthy Again agenda and the specific goals set by the current administration related to changes in policy to provide new standards for safety for food and pharmaceutical drugs in the U.S.?

- The survey numbers show the overall MAHA agenda to be popular with voters. Support for the agenda in general is in the seventy percent range, and approval of Robert Kennedy's performance as Secretary of HHS is over fifty percent.
- Confidence in the safety of vaccines in general is at fifty-seven percent, while confidence in Covid vaccines is less.
- Four-in-ten respondents say they know friends or family who encountered health problems and who speculate that it was the result of a Covid 19 vaccination.
- Seventy-one percent say they favor efforts to remove artificial dyes and

- coloring from foods they consume and about that same percent say they will buy products they like even after the colors and dyes have been removed.
- When it comes to food products grown in the soil, fifty-seven percent of respondents say they only buy organic products or buy organic when available. About that same percentage (59%) say they are concerned about food that is grown in soil using synthetic fertilizer or pesticides.
- While seventy percent of respondents said they would be more likely to buy produce and food that was organic and carried the FDA

Seal, sixty-five percent said they could not do so if the products were more costly. That percentage almost entirely reverses when asked if they would buy such food and produce without the use of pesticides and fertilizers at no increased cost.

 While only forty-nine percent of respondents were aware of news reports that the loss of topsoil in America is threatening the country's food supply, seventy percent favored Senator Roger Martin's proposal to introduce legislation to avoid synthetic fertilizers and to use natural products for food growing soil. Finally, President Trumps
 announcement that he would bring back the Presidential Physical
 Fitness Test received an approval rating of over seventy percent.

The numbers in this survey, taken as a whole, show remarkable awareness and support for the goals and efforts of the MAHA agenda as we head into Autumn. Despite an onslaught of negative stories in traditional/legacy media aimed at Robert Kennedy, Jr. (and obviously President Trump), both the agenda and Kennedy's efforts appear to hold majority approval. This indicates that, as a standalone, the effort to

Make America Health Again, is politically popular with voters. This serves as a stable political and policy winner for President Trump and his administration, despite the uniqueness of its issues and potential implementation.
