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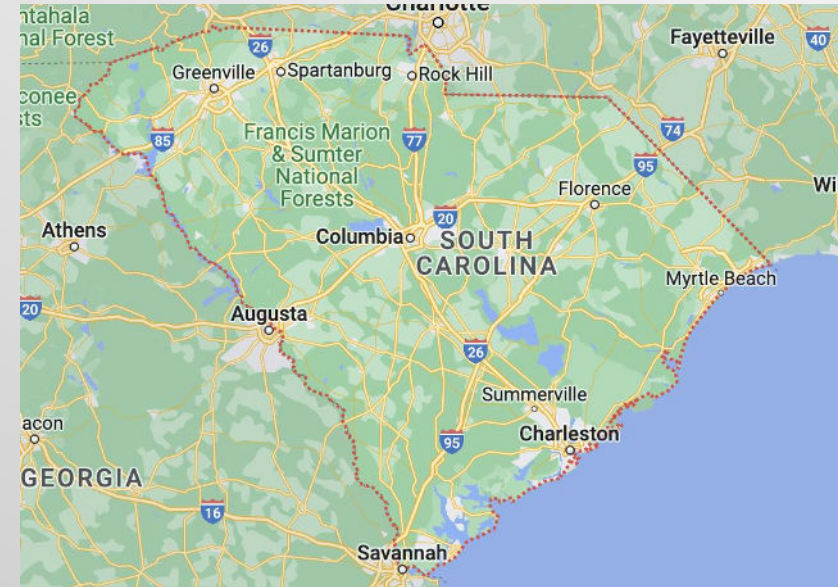

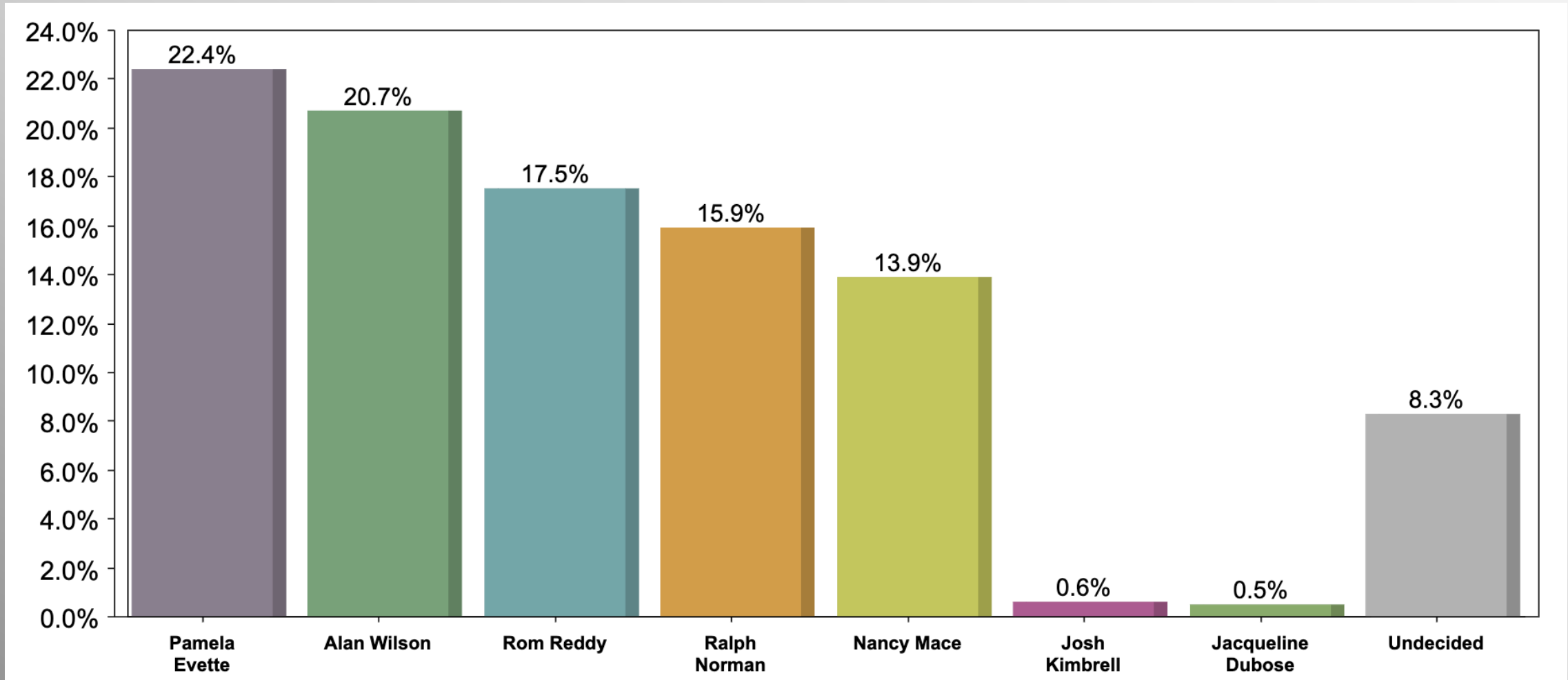

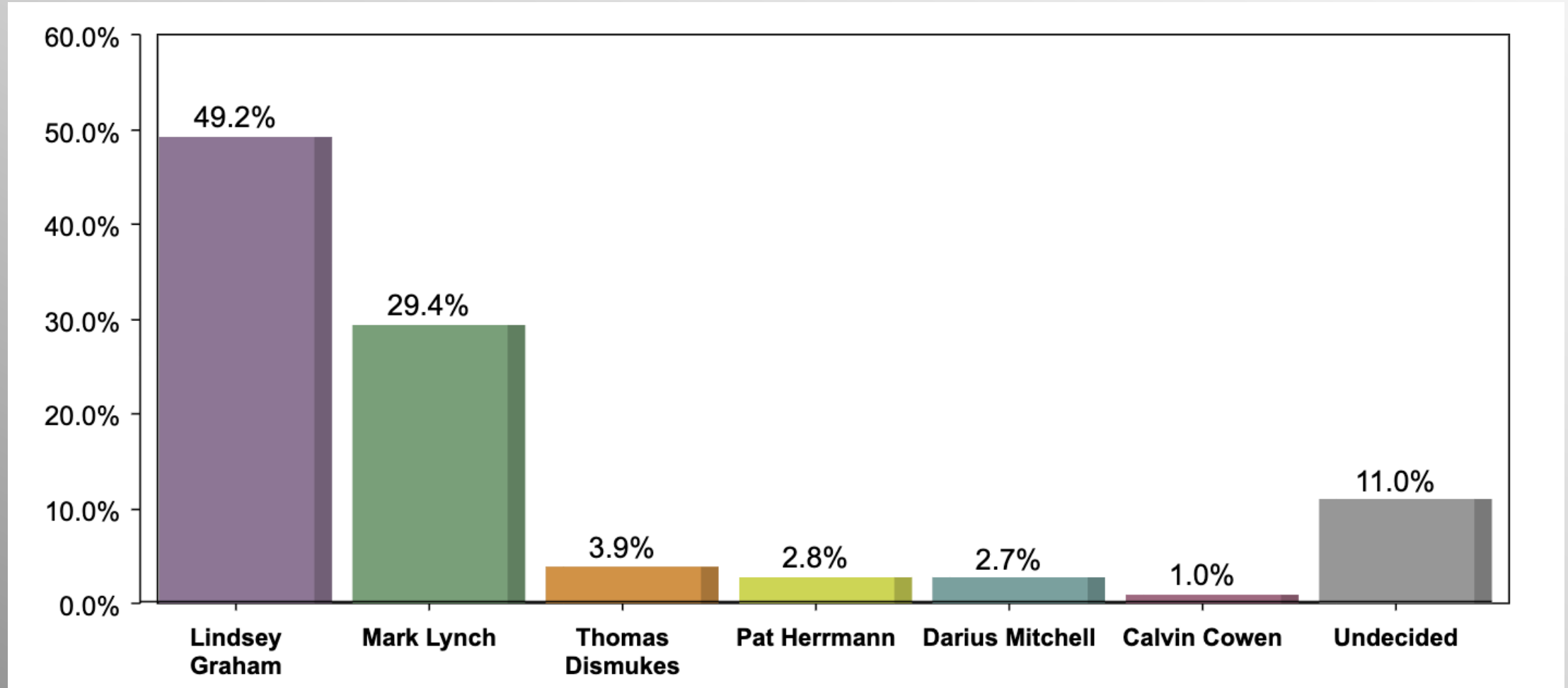
SC Governor GOP Primary

If the Republican primary for Governor were today and the following were your choices, for whom would you most likely vote?



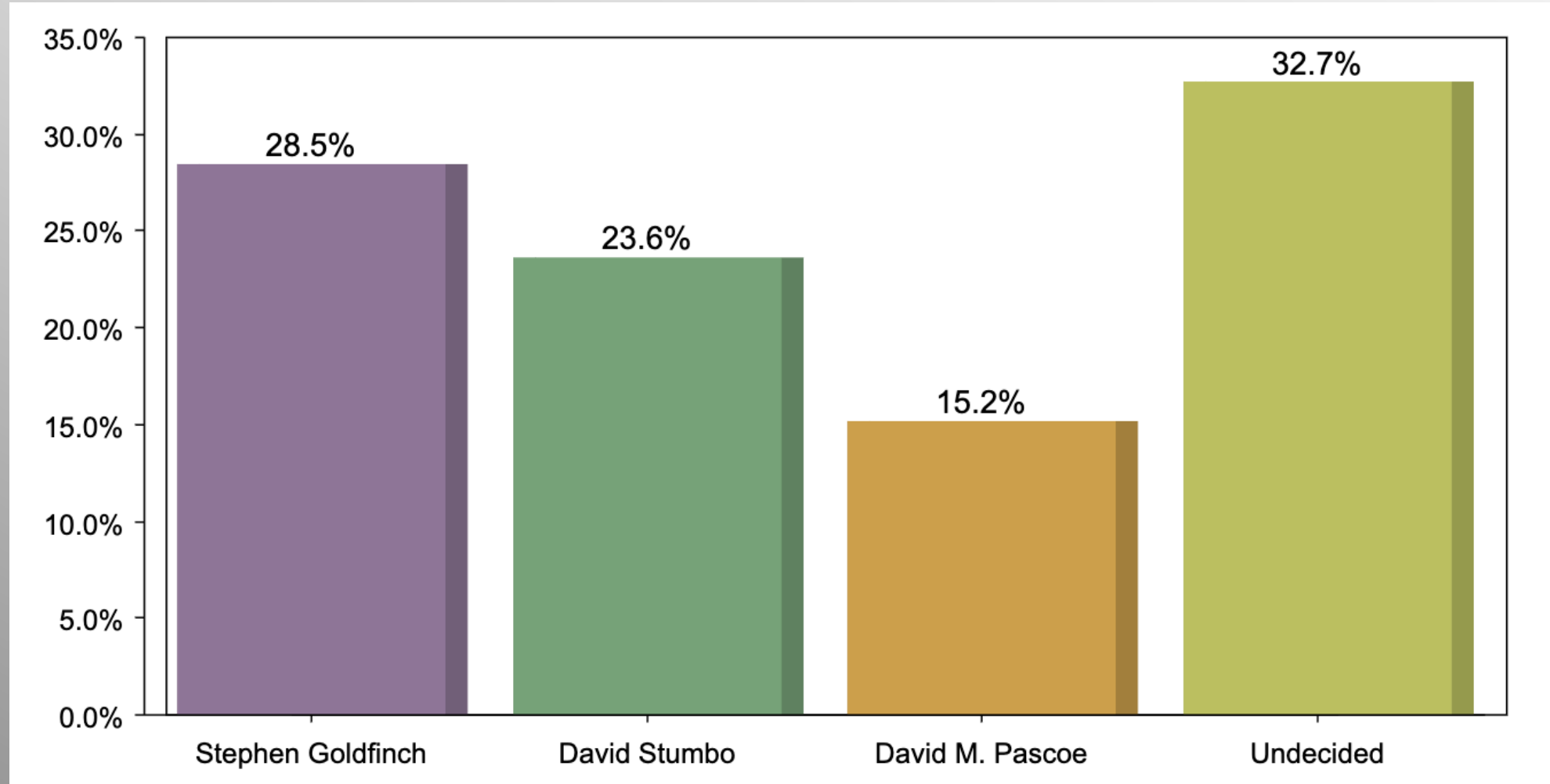
SC U.S. Senate GOP Primary

If the Republican primary for U.S. Senate were today and the following were your choices, for whom would you most likely vote?

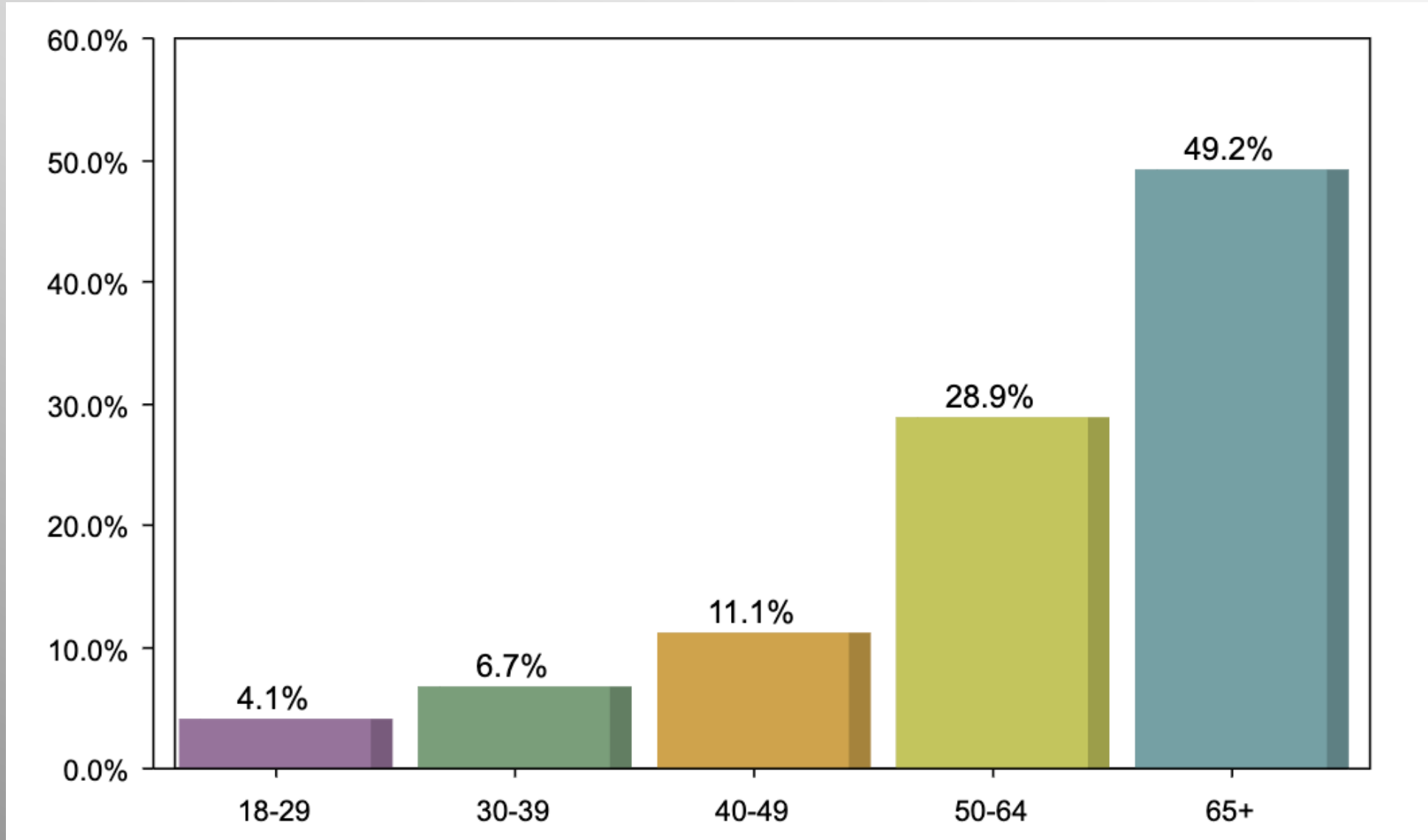

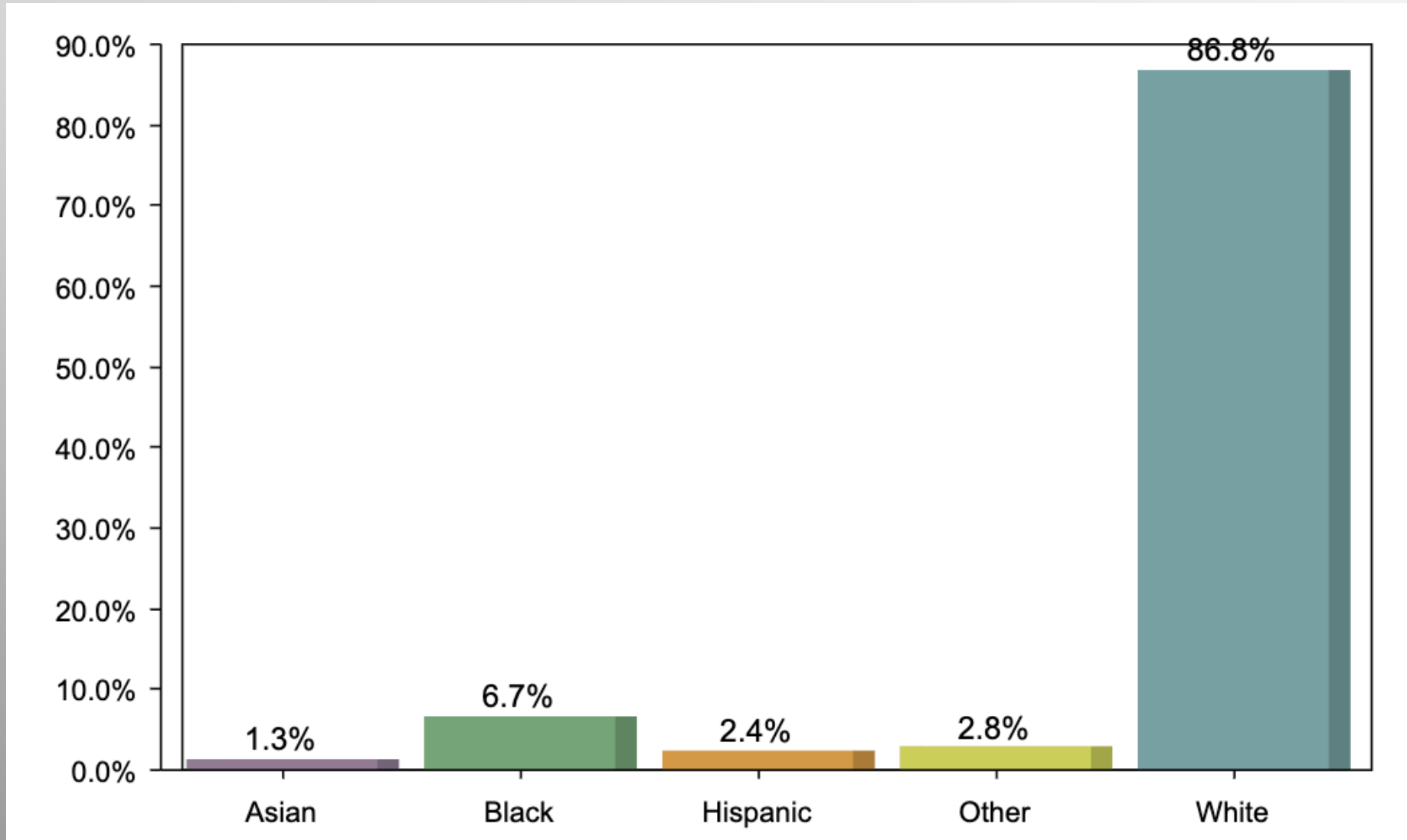
If the Republican primary for Attorney General were today and the following were your choices, for whom would you most likely vote?



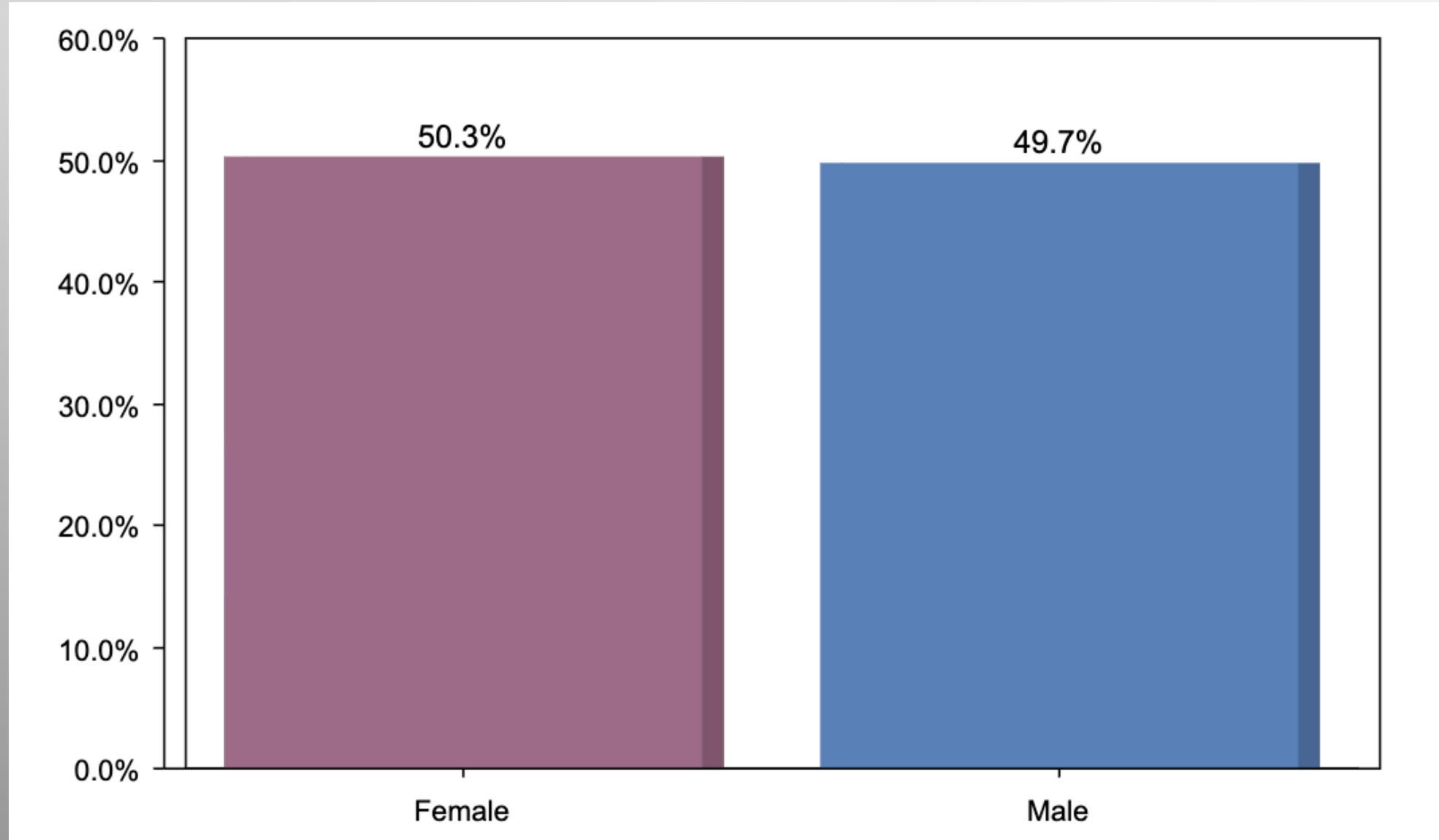
Age Participation
